Dear Resident:

The Board of Supervisors accepted a proposal from EB Walsh Associates on February 7, 2012 to engineer and design the improvements to the Hershey Mill Dam needed to bring the Dam into compliance with PA Department of Environmental Protection requirements. The improvements would consist of the construction of a secondary spillway east of the existing spillway. In addition the trees on the dam will be removed and the top of the dam would be raised approximately one foot at various locations to make the top of the dam level: however, the pond will not be dredged.

EB Walsh is ready to submit the plans and permit application to the PA Department of Environmental Protection for approval. However, it has been suggested that prior making the submission that the residents be afforded an opportunity to review and comment on the plans.

The plans and a rendering of what the dam would look like after the improvements have been constructed are posted on the Township Web Page, under the Township "Overview" tab.

In accordance with Township policy, this letter is being sent to all property owners within 1,000 feet of the Hershey Mill Dam. Its purpose is to let you know that this matter will be on the agenda for the Board of Supervisors meeting on October 2, 2012 at 7:00 pm at the Township Building.
