Also in attendance were: Ed Lendrat (Historical Commission 10 Research Volunteer), Gary Althouse (Township Building Inspector), and Joe McDonough (BOS Liaison). 11 12 1 & 2. CALL TO ORDER AND PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE 13 The Chairman called the meeting to order at 7:05 pm and led those present in the Pledge of Allegiance. 14 3. MINUTES 15 16 Ben moved to accept the minutes as corrected and Ellen seconded. No further discussion or comments were made. Joe Zug abstained due to not being in attendance on August 12th. The minutes of August 17 18 12, 2009 were unanimously approved as corrected. 19 20 **4. Activity Calendar-** Kathryn reviewed changes to the current calendar and made additions in bold face. 21 22 5. CHAIRMAN'S REPORT- No formal report this month. Additional comments will be made as 23 agenda items are discussed. 24 25 6. SUB-DIVISION/LAND DEVELOPMENT 26 Gary reported that potential buyers (please note that the potential buyers are present at this meeting) of 1422 Paoli Pike are looking for adapted use of the property. 27 28 29 7. LIAISON REPORTS 30 31 Planning Commission- Jason reported that many East Goshen and West Goshen residents attended to 32 express mostly negative response to the possible construction of an independent living facility in West 33 Goshen in the vicinity of the Route 202 entrance and Greehill Road. It is called Traditions. It was also 34 mentioned that the widening of Boot Road will not be happening. 35 36 <u>Board of Supervisors</u> – Kathryn reported that the BOS meeting also spoke of Traditions. Many issues 37 are of concern including how this will affect emergency services in this area and water runoff to 38 neighboring areas. Joe McDonough noted that the West Goshen hearing has been delayed until 39 October. 40 41 8. OTHER MATTER 42 43 Prospective buyers Dr. Tanya and Alex Zelensky, along with their attorney, Jennifer Levy-Tatum were 44 in attendance to discuss with the HC the possibility of the Zelensky's purchasing the property at 1422 45 Paoli Pike to convert it to an office space for Dr. Zelensky's medical practice. The Zelensky's are interested in razing the barn, using the existing building as a reception area, and adding a one story 46 47 addition to the right of the property towards the garage. The plot of land that the barn now stands on

- **B**. Hershey's Mill Dam- an article appeared in the Daily Local on page 3. A core group has been developed and it is thought that \$300,000 will need to be raised by the residents. The Core Group is to meet on August 31st. Kathryn noted that all options are being reviewed at this time.
- C. <u>Living History Day-</u> A review of the activities roster was conducted. Dolores noted that she has purchased a photo printer and showed a sample of a picture card that will be available for a small donation. Ellen suggested that the HC should charge \$1.00 per portrait. Kathryn reviewed the assignments for the day. Dolores also distributed packets of posters along with a list of area stores to hang the posters.

D. <u>Family Research</u> – Ed Lendrat noted that current research is going slow and will report at the next meeting.

E. Other Old Business – The October 17 Illumination at Paoli Battlefield has a new script. Kathryn distributed a handout about Eagle Scout projects and Girl Scout Merit Badges.

9. NEW BUSINESS.

 A. Education programs with schools will be discussed in October. **B**. The Township website is to be revamped and reviewed.

 C. August expense report was reviewed. Dolores suggested that the liaison reports be moved to the end of the agenda and the expense report to the top. Line items for the budget were reviewed in great detail.
