41	7.	OLD BUSINESS						
42		A. <u>Brochure for the Battle of the Clouds</u> – Dolores distributed a sample of the brochure and						
43		explained the layout. The Cornwallis house and 3 Tun Tavern are two other buildings						
44		that are still original that could be used on the back of the brochure.						
45		Discussion –						
46		1. It was pointed out that Howe is referred to as "Lord" and "General".						
47		Everyone agreed he should be referred to as "General" throughout the						
48		brochure.						
49		2. The request for information on the back should be in bold.						
50		3. The township website should be added under the address on the front of

14		5. The signs for the Plank House and Blacksmith Shop should have the
15		cream text box repeated on the reverse and no logo on the reverse.
16		6. Everyone agreed they don't like the two lines of changeable letters as
17		shown on page 1. Judy will get information about rider/hanging signs
18		(cost, construction, how they will be attached, etc). Everyone will think
19		about what type of signs should be used (open, closed, special event,
20		etc.)
21		Judy said the signs are aluminum. Ben is concerned about putting holes in the signs for
22		the rider signs. The Township will put the posts in so there will be no cost for that. Judy
23		wants the designer to come here and see the site. She has set May 1 st as the deadline for

The Bureau for Historic Preservation (the State Historic Preservation Office) has reviewed the above named project in accordance with Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act of 1966, as amended in 1980 and 1992, and the regulations (36 CFR Part 800) of the Advisory Council on Historic Preservation as revised in 1999 and 2004. These regulations require consideration of the project's potential effect upon both historic and archaeological resources.

Thank you for providing the results of the balloon test for the above referenced project. The results indicate that the proposed tower will be visible within the Goshenville Historic District. Where the tower is clearly visible, a significant amount of modern development has occurred. In other places within the historic district that has not experienced modern development; the proposed tower is minimally visible. Based on this information, it is our opinion the proposed project will have no adverse effect on the National Register listed Goshenville Historic District. Thank you for your cooperation.
