Meters:

Were read on a daily basis. We were having problems with the portable meters reading negative flows. Allied Control was notified and the

problems have been corrected.

C.C. Collection:

All pump stations were visited on a daily basis, no problems to report. We were notified of a lateral clog on Cooper Circle, the trap was plunged which cleared the clog. We inspected two lateral connections on the system; both were located on Manley Road; one required us to have a public works employee on site; since they were digging around the Ash Bridge force main. We replaced all the manhole castings on Wilson Drive and Morstein Road as part of our paving program. Three of the casting showed signs of inflow. We televised a thousand feet of sewer line on Reservoir Road, there were no problems to report.

R.C. Collection:

The pumping station was visited on a daily basis; we did have a problem at the Hershey Mill Pump Station when a circuit board shorted out. We had a spare board in stock which was changed out and the station was returned to normal operation. We inspected two lateral installations on Cornwallis Drive. The sewer right of ways were mowed.

R.C. Plant:

No problems to report.

404 Barker Drive replaced clean- out and traps.

201 Lockwood Lane, new caps.

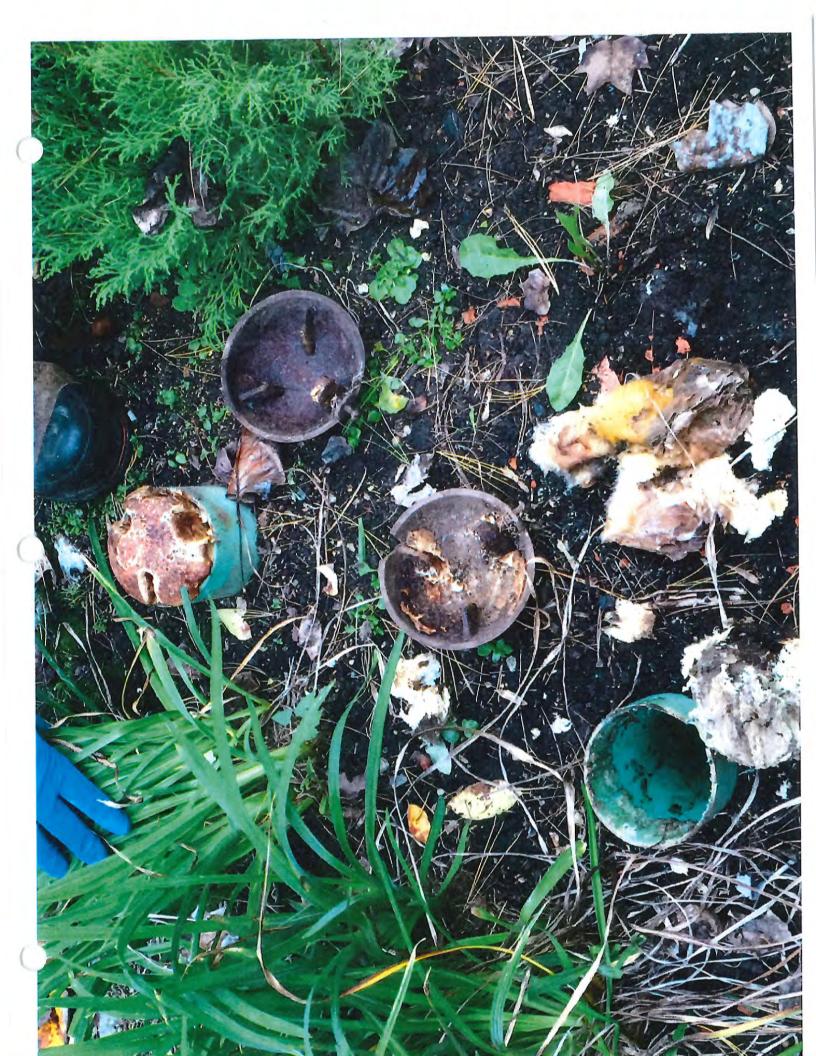
We also repaired a dozen clean- out pipes on both collection systems.

Reservoir Road Pump Station Act 537 Plan

- The Act 537 Plan Update was submitted to PADEP on August 25, 2014. PADEP has reviewed the Plan Update, and they provided two comments which we are in the process of addressing:
 - We expect to submit revised Plan Update pages to address a project scheduling comment by October 14.
 - The second comment sis that U.S. Fish & Wildlife Service (USFWS) approval is required. It is our understanding that Conestoga-Rovers & Associates resubmitted revised plans to USFWS around July 10 to address their bog turtle protection comments at the Chester Creek crossing. We are still awaiting USFWS's formal approval, and we have contacted them again to request a written approval.

Semi-Annual Sewer Status Report

• We analyzed permanent and portable meter data for the past six-month period. We met with the Township Manager and PW Director to discuss conclusions and recommendations. We also met with the meter service company and PW staff at several portable meter manhole locations to observe meter installations, manhole conditions, and calibrations. A semi-annual status memo was forwarded to the Township.

EGMA 1401

Sewer Ordinance Updates

• We prepared proposed revisions to the Building Sewer and Grinder Pump sections of the Township's Sewers Ordinance. We also prepared a new typical building sewer detail. We met with the Township Manager and PW Director to review the proposed revisions. A second set of ordinance revisions was made thereafter and was forwarded to the Township for review, along with an example grinder pump operations and maintenance agreement.

New Sewer Connections

• We received a revised grinder pump plan submission for a proposed house at 610 Reservoir Road that is scheduled for review.



Monthly Operations Report: September 2014

Treatment Process Operation

During August 2014, there were no exceedances of the final effluent discharge limitations for outfall 001 and discharge from Outfall 002. The total phosphorus monthly average concentration of 0.25 mg/L as compared to the permitted limitation of 0.50 mg/L. Table 1 illustrates the final effluent composite sample data reported for the August 2014 eDMR. During the month, the final effluent total phosphorus concentration discharged ranged from 0.23 mg/L to 0.27 mg/L. A daily average of 99 gpd of aluminum sulfate solution was used as compared to the 92 gpd average for July.

The influent wastewater pollutant concentrations and loading entering the wastewater treatment facility remained within the design concentrations and loadings. Composite samples are collected at the influent doghouse manhole and influent wet well. The influent flow meter reading is collected from the influent flow meter located prior to the Screening Building, excluding the internal recycle flows.

Table 6 presents the available pollutant data for the influent wastewater collected at the doghouse manhole during September.

Sequencing batch reactors (SBRs) numbered 1, 3 and 4 were in service during August and September.

Process monitoring of each SBR included ammonia as N, nitrite as N, Nitrate as N, COD, SSV, MLSS and total phosphorus. Foam concentrations decreased slightly during September to as low as 40% coverage of the surface area. Increased sludge wasting rates were maintained to manage the MLSS concentrations and F:M ratio within the desired goals. Aeration time was remained at a minimum of 230 minutes to provide for a total of approximately 63% of aeration during the 360 minute treatment cycle. The extended aeration period assists to offset the oxygen demand after extended periods of idle time between treatment cycles.

Daily monitoring of the influent and final effluent 24-hour composites samples for total phosphorus is ongoing. Daily analysis of the final effluent flow equalization grab sample is total phosphorus is ongoing. Sample collection and analysis of the influent wastewater collected at the influent pump station wet well is ongoing.



Addition of aluminum sulfate solution to the SBRs to assist with phosphorus removal continued. The volume of aluminum sulfate solution to the SBRs was slightly increased from a daily average of 92 gpd during July to 99 gpd during September to assist with total phosphorus removal. The aluminum sulfate dosages prior to filtration remained constant during August and September. The increase in alum addition, as well as the increased idle times, resulted in an increase in soda ash addition. During August, the soda ash addition average decreased slightly to approximately 435 lbs./day, as compared to 416 lbs./day during July. Soda ash assists towards maintaining pH concentrations above 7.0 standard units continued during the month.

SBR No. 2 remains out of service as a treatment unit, however, partially filled with MLSS which continuously mixed and aerated.

During August, sludge wasting to the sludge holding tanks and decanting of the sludge holding tanks was ongoing. Process monitoring included pH, total alkalinity and total solids.

Sludge holding tank No. 1 was in service. The level at the beginning of the month was 8.19 feet and the level at the end of the month was 7.93 feet. The initial total solids concentration was 0.74% and ended the month as 0.67% total solids. The average pH concentration was 7.40 S.U. and total alkalinity of 285 mg/L. Zero gallons of supernatant were decanted during the month. A total of 100 pounds of soda ash were added during the month for pH adjustment.

Sludge holding tank No. 2 was in service. The level at the beginning of the month was 11.57 feet and the level at the end was 5.77. The initial total solids concentration were 0.69% and ended the month as 0.68% total solids. The average pH concentration was 7.23 S.U. and total alkalinity of 355 mg/L. A total of 55,440 gallons of supernatant were decanted during the month. A total of 350 pounds of soda ash were added during the month for pH adjustment.

Significant Storm/Hydraulic Loading Events

Attached please find a revised proposed 2015 budget for the Municipal Authority.

Revenues

• This budget proposes revenues of \$121,016, including \$105,105 as a transfer from the sewer operating fund and \$14,296 from two Ridley Creek tap-in fees on Colonial Lane.

Expenses

- Expenses reflect \$9,000 for legal fees and \$37,300 for engineering, of which \$12,000 is anticipated for general engineering, \$10,500 for I&I reports and \$14,800 for Chapter 94 reports.
- The remaining expenses include \$10,800 for auditing, \$33,323 for administrative overhead, and \$27,409 for the Municipal Authority's share of debt service on the 1998 notes.
- The budget also reflects \$100,000 in engineering costs for the Reservoir Road pump station project (new). These expenses will be paid form the proceeds of the 2013 notes.

The projected fund balance at the end of 2015 is expected to be \$1,470,894, the majority of which represents the remaining balance of the proceeds from the 2013 notes.

I recommend that the Municipal Authority approve the proposed budget prior to the end of the calendar year.

Semi-Annual Sewer System Status Report Progress Update

The portable metering investigation shifted focus to the Ridley Creek Service Area during the current period from March 2014 through August 2014. The meter data from the current period indicates inflow and infiltration (I/I) occurs in the Ridley Creek Service Area, but we question the accuracy of the some of the data.

Six of the portable meters were relocated to the Ridley Creek Service Area in early August 2014, so there is only approximately two months of data available for those meters. A significant rainfall event did not occur while those portable meter were in place, so it cannot be determined if the continuous base flow is correlated with rainfall. A brief summary of the portable meter flows from the current period are provided below:

Reservoir Road Interceptor, MH C-036: Data from the current period indicates peak flows occur during storm events, likely due to inflow. The 3.5-inch rainstorm on April 30th, 2014 resulted in a daily volume of 1,640,952 gpd, which is the highest daily flow recorded at this location since the temporary meter was installed in November 2012. Flows during this period were lower than previous periods, but the metered data from the current period does not reflect the significant reduction that was expected after a major leak was repaired along the interceptor upstream. Additionally, the portable meter flows are significantly less than the immediate downstream permanent Reservoir Road meter so we recommend a portable meter be installed immediately downstream of the permanent meter to evaluate the inconsistencies.

<u>Line Road, MH R-238:</u> Flows were relatively consistent and are believed to be accurate considering the number of upstream connections. The continuous base flow is only 10 gpm which indicates there is limited infiltration in upstream sewers during dry weather periods.

East Boot Road, MH R-013: Flows at this location were relatively consistent from August 2014 through September. The average base comprises nearly 40% (28 gpm) of the total flow at this location, which may be evidence of upstream I/I.

Ashcom, MH R-638: We question the accuracy of the portable meter data since flows at this location are significantly lower than expected considering the number of upstream connections.

Blacksmith Shop, MH R-021 / East Boot Road, MH R-018 / Tegler, MH R-003: We question the accuracy of these portable meters. Since the upstream metered flows at the Blacksmith Shop are significantly more than the downstream meters on the Ridley Creek Interceptor and none are consistent with influent flows to the RCSTP.

We met in the field with a flow metering service representative and East Goshen Public Works staff on October 1, 2014 to inspect several portable meters that produced questionable data. We discovered several of the meters needed to be recalibrated which was completed by adjusting the meter using a hand measurement of the flow depth in the pipe.

The Blacksmith Shop portable meter was installed backwards so the velocities were negative values. Additionally, the meter produced high flows after being calibrated, but this may have been due the time of day, approximately 8 A.M., when peak flows are expected. We also observed high turbulent flows in the manhole which was not observed in other manholes with portable meters. The turbulent flow at this manhole could be affecting the accuracy of the meter, so after further analysis we may recommend moving the meter one manhole upstream if the data continues to be inaccurate.

We suggest that the meters be recalibrated during each weekly visit to download the flow data. We recommend that all of the portable meters remain in the same locations over the next six months. We will analyze recalibrated meter data from all the portable meters over the next two months and issue Sewer System Status Report #12 by the end of the year.
