## 1 Draft 2 EAST GOSHEN TOWNSHIP 3 PLANNING COMMISSION MEETING 4 **February 6, 2013** 5 6 The East Goshen Township Planning Commission held a regularly scheduled meeting on Wednesday, February 6, 7 2013 at 7:00 p.m. at the East Goshen Township building. Members present were: Chairman Susan Carty, Dan 8 Daley, Al Zuccarello, Adam Knox, George Martynick, Jim McRee, and Nathan Cline. Also present were Charles 9 Proctor, Township Supervisor; Monica Close, Historical Commission; Erich Meyer, Park and Recreation 10 Commission; and Sandra Snyder, Conservancy Board. 11 12 A. WORKSESSION - 7:00 PM 13 1. It was decided that Sue and Dan will be the primary members of the Comprehensive Plan Committee and 14 Adam and George will be the alternates. 15 2. Minutes of January 2, 2013 were corrected. 16 3. Neal Fisher was present to represent New Kent Apartments. He reviewed the few items that were on the 17 Yerkes review letter and stated that New Kent would comply with all of them. Nate mentioned the letter 18 from the Fire Marshall and Neal stated they would comply. Jim pointed out that he hasn't seen conditions #4 19 & #5 on a draft motion before. Neal is okay with them and agreed to all of the conditions. 20 Sue gave an update on the meeting with representatives from Dunkin Donuts. They are considering the 21 Citadel Bank building as a new location. Their hours of operation are 5:30 am to 10:00 pm, with peak hours 22 from 5:30 am to 10:00 am. They anticipate 725 trips/day with 60% of their customers coming during peak 23 hours. They are planning for stacking of 6 cars in the drive thru. They are a fast food restaurant. They will 24 ask for sign and use variances. Traffic flow and safety issues were discussed. 25 26 B. FORMAL SESSION - 7:40 PM 27 1. Sue called the meeting to order at 7:40 pm and led the Pledge of Allegiance. 28 There was a moment of silence to remember our armed forces. 29 Sue asked if anyone would be recording the meeting. There was no response. 30 31 2. Minutes – Sue noted that the minutes of the January 2, 2013 meeting were approved as corrected. 32 33 3. Land Development Plan – New Kent Apartments, N. Chester Rd and Boot Rd – Al moved that the 34 Planning Commission recommend that the Board of Supervisors approve the Preliminary/Final Land 35 Development Plan of the Hankin Group to construct one new apartment building and associated parking as 36 depicted within the plans titled New Kent Apartments II, dated 10/9/12 and last revised on 1/28/13 with the 37 following conditions: 38 a. The Applicant shall address all remaining comments outlined in the Township Engineer's review 39 letter dated 1/31/13 prior to approval. 40 b. The Applicant will follow all applicable federal, state and local laws and secure all proper 41 permits prior to construction of the improvements depicted on the plans. 42 c. The Plan shall not be released for recording until all of the escrow for the improvements depicted 43 on the plans has been posted. 44 d. The applicant shall pay 10% of the sewer tap-in fee to reserve the sewer capacity for the project, 45 prior to the plans being released for recording. 46 e. Applicant will comply with comments in Fire Marshall's letter. 47 f. Applicant shall have a letter from the Conservation District before approval. 48 Jim seconded the motion. The motion passed. Dan abstained from voting. 49 50 4. Article II - The Commission reviewed the comments and recommendations for Article II provided by 51 Mark Gordon. Jim is interested in the Animal Husbandry section. He will develop a definition of Animal 52 Husbandry and clarify that definition throughout the ordinance. Bees will not be included. Dan read the 53 current definitions in the ordinance about size of animals, number of animals allowed, acreage required,

setbacks, etc.

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15 16 Public Comment: Sandy Snyder suggested that Jim look at the ordinances for Lancaster County townships.

5. Friends of East Goshen – Chuck Proctor will be organizing a 501c3 committee to replace the Friends of East Goshen Committee that disbanded last year. The steering committee will have its first meeting Tuesday, February 12, 2013 at 7:00 pm at the Township Building. He has 4 volunteers so far and invited anyone else who would be interested.

The next meeting will be held on Wednesday, March 6, 2013 at 7:00 pm. There being no further business, a motion to adjourn the meeting was made by Dan and seconded by Nate. The meeting adjourned at 8:45 pm.
