# CALL TO ORDER/PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

PJ asked Jason to lead the Pledge of Allegiance.

PJ asked for a moment of silence to remember our troops.

PJ asked if anyone would be recording the meeting. There was no response.

#### **ANY OTHER MATTER**

Erich Meyer announced that he is leaving the Park & Recreation Commission and will become a member of the Conservancy Board. PJ said that Erich will be missed. Also, the Commission needs to assign a primary member to the Comprehensive Plan Task Force.

### **APPROVAL OF MINUTES**

PJ noted that the minutes of the November 7, 2013 meeting were approved.
 PJ noted that the minutes of the December 5, 2013 meeting were approved.

RECREATION DIRECTOR

Jason Lang gave his background and reviewed the 100 day plan he developed. A survey was sent to the residents asking for their input on programs and events. He should start receiving some back tomorrow. In addition to the newsletter, website and constant contact, Jason likes to provide videos to show what a program is like. He will offer some programs at several different times during the day in order to meet the needs of all families. Most of the programs will be held in the park. The start date of the classes will coincide with the newsletter. Carmen asked if he needed any seed money. Jason explained that the programs will run on participant fees. However, Robotic Legos is a program for kids ages 6-12 where they learn to build things that move. The program will run for 4 weeks and the fee is \$125/week/child. He is requesting \$4,400 seed money to purchase laptops and software. Heidi made a motion to approve the Robotic Legos program and give Jason seed money not to exceed \$5,000 to purchase the items needed to start this program. Ann Marie seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

#### **FARMERS MARKET**

Jason announced that he will be the manager of the Farmers Market. He has met with the Committee members, Heidi, Ann Marie and John, who have given so much of their time to make this venture the success that it is. Jason has extensive experience with these types of programs and thanked the Committee for the base of vendors and community contacts that are available for him. The dates (one week per month) for the remainder of the winter are posted on the website. He met Tuesday night with the vendors to start planning the summer farmers market.

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**OPEN SPACE PLAN** 

Heidi attended the meeting and explained that the purpose is to update the current plan. They need to protect the waterways which is easier to do since the Township owns most of the land along the creeks. They had a presentation using aerial maps which she would like to have made to the Park & Rec Commission. The next meeting is Jan. 23 and Joe will attend.

#### ANNUAL ABC MEETING

This meeting has been changed from this Saturday, Jan. 11 to Saturday Jan. 25, at 9:00 am. Accomplishments for 2013 were discussed.

- 1. Community Day 2013 was the first time the Park Commission sold merchandise to raise revenue. It went very well and made a profit which will be used toward the 2014 Community Day.
- 2. Farmers Market The Committee members estimate that they volunteered 15-30 hours per week for this project. They rebuilt the communications network with a value of \$10,000. They coordinated with the Goshen Fire Company, the WEGO Police Chief and the West Chester Farmers Market. They created a strong community base and brought authors to the market for book signings. They had excellent publicity through the Daily Local News. The local radio station, WCHE, did broadcasts from the market at the park.

Heidi asked everyone to email comments to her. She will put a report of 2013 accomplishments and 2014 goals together and email it before the Jan. 25<sup>th</sup> meeting.

There being no further business Joe moved to adjourn the meeting. Ann Marie seconded the motion. The meeting was adjourned at 8:30 pm.
