Dear Resident:

As you may be aware, the Sunoco Station at the corner of Boot Road and Paoli Pike had a release of unleaded gasoline in 2006. The Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection (PA DEP) has been overseeing and monitoring the remediation of this spill since that time. As part of this process, Sunoco undertook a number of steps: including drilling monitoring wells both on their property and adjoining properties, the testing of these wells and private wells in the vicinity in order to determine the extent of the release.

This information was compiled over the last few years and early this year Sunoco submitted their Site Characterization Report to PA DEP. The Report concluded that the area affected by the release is confined to the Sunoco Station, the CVS parking lot and the Township property just south of the Station. The PA DEP approved the Site Characterization Report on April 21, 2010.

Sunoco has recently installed the ground water remediation equipment at the Station and is expected that it will be in operation next week.

It was suggested that the Township ask representaives from both PA DEP and Sunoco to attend a public meeting to update interested Township residents on what has transpired since the release and what is expected to occur going forward.

Representatives from PA DEP and Sunoco have agreed to attend the Board's meeting on July 20, 2010 at 8:00 pm to provide an update on this matter.

RESOLUTION NO. 10-___

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING SPECIFIC PROVISIONS OF THE DEER MANAGEMENT PROGRAM FOR THE 2010-2011 SEASON

WHEREAS, Section 163-4B of the Code of the Township of East Goshen requires the Board of Supervisors to designate the areas of Township land to be utilized for hunting as part of the Deer Management Program; and

WHEREAS, Section 163-4D of the Code of the Township of East Goshen authorizes the Board of Supervisors to identify Deer Management Groups to participate in the program; and

WHEREAS, Section 163-4F of the Code of the Township of East Goshen requires the Board of Supervisors to designate the days and times when deer management activities may occur; and

WHEREAS, Section 163-4G of the Code of the Township of East Goshen requires the Board of Supervisors to designate the procedure for reporting harvested deer; and

WHEREAS, Section 163-4H of the Code of the Township of East Goshen requires the Board of Supervisors to designate the procedure for reporting complaints; and

WHEREAS, Section 163-4I of the Code of the Township of East Goshen allows the Board of Supervisors to designate by resolution additional guidelines and procedures.

BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Board of Supervisors of the Township of East Goshen hereby adopts the following specific provisions for the 2010-2011 Deer Management Program:

Pursuant to Section 163-4B, the Board of Supervisors designates the open space in Bowtree/Clocktower, Supplee Valley East & West, Grand Oak/Millcreek and Wentworth for hunting as part of the Deer Management Program.

Pursuant to Section 163-4D, the Board of Supervisors authorizes the following Deer Management Groups to participate in the program: Chester County Trackers, Deer Management Professionals, Main Line Whitetail Managers, and Tri-County Deer Management.

Pursuant to Section 163-4F, the Board of Supervisors authorizes the following dates and times: hunting may occur as outlined by the Pennsylvania Game Commission beginning

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September 18, 2010 until January 29, 2011, excluding the following dates: November 25, 26 and 27, 2010 and December 27, 2010 thru January 1, 2011.

Pursuant to Section 163-4G, the Board of Supervisors authorizes the following procedure for reporting harvested deer: Each hunter shall complete the Deer Management Program Harvest Report form for each harvested deer and forward it to the Township electronically within 48 hours of harvesting a deer.

Pursuant to Section 163-4H, the Board of Supervisors authorizes the following procedure for reporting complaints: Complaints shall be filed in writing and hand delivered or emailed to the Township using the following email address: egtadmin@eastgoshen.org.

Pursuant to Section 163-4I, the Board of Supervisors has no additional guidelines or procedures to designate at this time.

Dear East Goshen Township Commissioners,

Being an ex-Navy Seabee, a retired maintenance mechanic for a U.S. Naval training facility and a volunteer fire fighter for 30 years, I am very aware of how hectic a situation can become after a catastrophic event such as the sudden storm we experienced on June 24th. Anything and everything that can go wrong...will and everyone wants it fixed immediately and sometimes that can be an overwhelming task to say the least. I would like to take this opportunity to commend the staff of East Goshen Township and especially your public works staff for a job well done in getting our community up and running in a matter of a few days after seeing the daunting devastation that surrounded us. It is a sad moment that the public you serve comes to expect and assume that because they 'pay taxes'...well, you know the rest but that same public often forget how far a little respect, a simple thank you and hand shake will go.

This letter is to recognize a few key individuals on your staff. First, let me say that everyone I spoke with at the township building was calm and polite, did not put me on hold, answered my questions and called me back when they said they would. In this world of 'don't care attitudes', these are rare qualities not often found and were very refreshing. From the receptionist who took and directed my calls and later called me back (sorry, I don't know your name) to Mr. Mark Miller, Mr. Kevin Miller and Mr. Mike Ennis from public works who handled the clean up operations in my situation, a heart felt thank you from myself and Mrs. Volz.

Mrs. Volz lives alone and is widowed for 10 years and currently ambulatory due to a recent fall. I have been her St. Michael, as she often calls me, for many years often handling the maintenance needs on her property. The storm took out 5 trees and a ton of debris on her land, 1 tree landing on Rt. 352 and blocking one lane of traffic for a couple of hours. After surveying the damage, I myself, was somewhat overwhelmed. Being that Navy Seabee with a 'can do' attitude and working alone over several days, I cut up the 5 trees and amassed about 3 dump truck loads of brush and branches with no means of disposal. I have no pickup truck so hauling away was not an option and only being allowed 3 trash cans to the curb would take me months to remove the branches. I contacted Mr. Mark Miller to see if there were other options and to make a long story short, he advised me on what to do, where to place the brush and had his crew come get it without a whimper. I offered a gratuity and beverages which he, as a dedicated and honest public servant; adamantly declined, saying only a letter of thank you would be sufficient.

So THANK YOU township receptionist, Mark, Kevin and Mike for a job well done. You are a credit to your positions and community and it is people like you that make this township the great place it is. I only hope this letter gets you that promotion and pay raise you truly deserve.


Manhole Cover Lids

On a recent inspection of the manholes in Bowtree and Hunt Country, we found that the pick holes on the manholes are $1\,\%$ to $1\,\%$ openings, whereas there should be no openings on the covers. These openings allow for huge amounts of inflow.

I have started to replace the covers with ones we already had in stock. However, I will need an additional 35 to complete the project and 10 to keep in stock.

The total cost will be \$5,580.00 with a delivery time of 7 weeks.
