As of January 31, 2014, the general fund had year-to-date revenues of \$377,245 compared to expenses of \$1,076,285 for a negative variance of \$699,040, excluding pass through accounts. Compared to the YTD budget, revenues were \$38,543 over-budget, while expenses were \$63,238 under-budget for a negative budget variance of \$24,694. The general fund balance was \$5,584,763. I expect the general fund balance to be sharply higher in February as the combination of the discounted real estate tax payments and Earned Income Tax receipts from the historically strong February returns are deposited.

Net of core revenues, Administration, Public Works and Zoning & Code Enforcement were over-budget (\$26,910, \$50,795 and \$928, respectively), while Emergency Services and Park & Recreation were underbudget. Public Works was over-budget due to the series of major snow events in January (the snow budget was \$54,512 over-budget). Administration was over-budget due primarily to the timing of when Township insurance policies were paid.

Among non-core revenues, real estate taxes were \$111,402 over-budget due to Brian getting the real estate bills out in late January (rather than February 1) to take advantage of the lower postal rates that expired at the end of the month.

#### Other funds

- The State Liquid Fuels Fund had no activity.
- The **Sinking Fund** had \$556 in revenue and \$16,047 in expenses (pressure sealer and brine machine). The fund balance is \$6,579,839.
- The **Transportation Fund** had \$21,268 in revenues (primarily impact fees) and \$3,120 in expenses. The fund balance is \$1,071,306.
- The **Sewer Operating Fund** had \$249,715 in revenues and \$276,695 in expenses. The fund balance is \$559,532.
- The **Refuse Fund** has \$81,384 in revenues and \$74,737 in expenses. The fund balance is \$790,295.
- The **Sewer Sinking Fund** had \$220 in revenues and \$19,456 in expenses. The fund balance is \$1,801,256.
- The Operating Reserve Fund had \$19 in revenues and no expense. The fund balance is \$500,027.
- The Events Fund had \$1 in revenue and no expenses. The fund balance is \$15,001.

As this would be a professional services contract, the Township is not required to use the low bidder. After balancing the five year cost against the appearance and ease of navigation of websites created by the vendors, I believe Revize Software Systems best combines strong design elements with reasonable costs. Below are a few screenshots of the work Revize Software Systems completed for other municipalities.





All the websites shown above are very user friendly while each website has a professional feel. All references that I contacted stated that Revize Software Systems did a great job redesigning their websites and highly recommended Revize Software Systems. The references also stated that Revize Software Systems provides outstanding customer support on an ongoing basis.

Another consideration is migrating content from the existing website to the new website. The proposal from Revize Software Systems does not include migration. I feel that I could migrate the information from the old website to the new website myself. By doing this myself, it allows us to remove outdated documents and information and will also save the Township money. All proposals listed above include migration costs excluding Revize Software Systems, EZ Site and EVO.

The 2014 budget includes \$5,100 for the redesign of the website. Thus, Revize's proposal would exceed the budget by \$2,900.

Based on the five year cost and quality of work provided to other Municipalities, I recommend that the Township award the bid for our website redesign to Revize Software Systems.

#### **RESOLUTION 2014-32**

WHEREAS, Chapter 200 of the East Goshen Township Code requires the issuance of permits for road openings.

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors adopts the following road restoration requirement for East Goshen Township roads.

2A- Modified compacted in one foot (1') lifts. No Exceptions.

25.0 mm bituminous concrete – six inches (6")

19.0 mm bituminous concrete - two inches (2")

9.5 mm bituminous concrete - one and one half inches (1.5")

Bituminous concrete shall be measured after compaction

Tack coat will be applied to both sides of cut back.

Sealer A/C-20 applied at joints.

R O W- will be restored as it was prior to work. Trenches must be compacted prior to top-soiling, raking and seeding. Contractor is responsible for getting grass established.

Contractors will be required to do a one foot (1') cut back on each side of trench. Contractors are required to call the Township Public Works Department for an inspection of the trench restoration. Twenty-four (24) hour notice is required. In the event that the trench is back filled without Township inspection, the contractor will be required to excavate the trench at his own cost.

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#### East Goshen Township Full Day Camp Frequently Asked Questions

When does registration begin for summer camp? Registration begins on Tuesday, March 1, 2014.

What is the cost of attending camp? \$175 per week, non-residents pay \$185.

**Do I need to pay the total cost of camp now?** Yes, the balance is due in full when registering your camper for the program.

**How do I register?** The Registration Form will be available online beginning March 1<sup>st</sup>. You can submit both the Registration Form and payment through our website. Registration is also available in-person at the Township Building or through standard mail. You will receive a personal confirmation from Jason Lang once your forms are received and processed.

Where is the camp site? The camp will be held jointly in two locations. The first half of the day will coincide with the traditional half day camp at East Goshen Elementary School. At 12pm, all campers signed up for the full day camp will be escorted by Camp staff to the East Goshen Park for the remainder of the camp day.

What are the camp hours? 9:00am-4:00pm, Monday – Friday.

What will my child do at the full day camp? Campers will follow a daily schedule of activities that will include: arts and crafts, outdoor and gym games, socialization games and FUN! The full day campers will go on two field trips: on Wednesday morning they will go to Regal Movies and on Thursday afternoon they will go to Chuck E Cheese for a pizza party.

**Do they have a "home base" while at the Park?** Yes, the campers will utilize the Hicks Pavilion as their home base during pick up, lunch time and during large group communications.

**Can I attend a field trip?** We welcome parents wishing to help on field trips. If you are interested in chaperoning on a field trip, please contact the Camps Coordinator. If the field trip requires purchasing tickets, the parent is responsible to purchasing their own tickets.
