RESOLUTION 2015-134

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING WATER METER
GUIDELINES FOR COMMERCIAL PROPERTIES SERVED BY
WELL WATER OR THAT HAVE DEDUCT METERS

WHEREAS, East Goshen Township invoices commercial properties for sewage treatment.

WHEREAS, five commercial properties have a well on premises and have installed a water meter in order for the Township to assess sewer rents and three additional commercial properties have installed a deduct meter for water usage that is not treated by the sewer system.

WHEREAS, inconsistent manual meter readings have led to confusion for Township staff and property managers alike.

BE IT RESOLVED THAT the East Goshen Township Board of Supervisors hereby establishes the following guidelines for commercial properties that have a well or a deduct meter.


Prior to January 1, 2016, commercial properties that are served by well water or that have installed a water meter in order to deduct water consumption not treated by sanitary sewer must replace their water meter with the meter described in East Goshen Township's Water Measuring Device Application. The water meter will be provided and installed by the Township at no cost to the property owner:




