RESOLUTION NO. 09-52

**A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING THE
POLICY WAIVING THE PENALTY FOR LATE
SEWER AND REFUSE PAYMENTS**

WHEREAS, the Township provides sewer and/or refuse service to residential, commercial and industrial properties in the Township; and

WHEREAS, the Township utilizes the U.S. Postal Service to mail the bills for these services on a quarterly basis; and

WHEREAS, the Township imposes a penalty if the sewer and refuse bills are not paid by a specific date; and

WHEREAS, the Township receives calls from sewer and refuse users who allege that they did not receive their original bill and want the penalty waived; and

WHEREAS, Board of Supervisors recognize that there may be cases in which the sewer or refuse bill was not delivered by the U.S. Postal Service and that it would be appropriate to waive the penalty.

BE IT RESOLVED THAT the East Goshen Township Board of Supervisors hereby adopts the following policy for waiving the penalty.


1. The sewer or refuse user must contact the Township during the current quarter.
2. The users account must be current.
3. The penalty will be waived provided full payment is received before the first day of the following quarter.
4. The Township will send the sewer or refuse user a letter advising them that the penalty has been waived and outlining the payment options.
5. The penalty can only be waived one time in any rolling three year period.
