

Hello Rick,

I wanted to take a moment and share with you our final steps in returning the Mariner East 1 line to service. As you know, land owners were mailed an informational letter back in late October 2014 informing them of our intention to return the Mariner East 1 line to service.

In doing so, beginning Friday, December 19th, maintenance and operations personnel will begin the process of filling the line from the western part of the state in Washington County to its destination in the Southeast Pennsylvania region at our Marcus Hook Industrial Complex, located in Marcus Hook, Pennsylvania and Claymont, Delaware.

- This stage will be completed section-by section as we move across the state:
 - o The process begins with the placement of nitrogen into the line;
 - o We then insert a device known as a "pig" to separate out the nitrogen and propane;
 - Immediately behind the pig, we then begin to introduce propane into the line on a section-by-section basis.

We anticipate this process taking 5 to 7 days. We will however take a pause over the Christmas Holiday delaying the process on or about December 23rd, and resuming right after the Holiday. While we undertake this process, additional resources will be staged throughout the sections and locations where the fill is taking place.

In keeping in line with past practices, all 911 centers will be notified to support communications to law enforcement agencies and emergency responders.
