The Chester County Department of Emergency Service advises that due to conditions at the Milltown Dam in East Goshen Township, the public should avoid the area downstream of the dam specifically low lying areas along the Chester Creek south of the dam and north of the Cheyney University. Stay tuned for further information.

REPEAT PERIODICALLY

EVACUATION MESSAGE:

The Chester County Department of Emergency Service is advising all residents living downstream of the Milltown Dam in East Goshen Township to evacuate the area immediately. Evacuate the low-lying areas south of the dam and north of Cheyney University. If you require shelter during this emergency you should report to the Goshen Fire House at 1320 Park Avenue.

REPEAT PERIODICALLY

INCIDENT RESOLVED, SAFE TO RETURN:

The Chester County Department of Emergency Service is advising residents of the area downstream of the Milltown Dam in East Goshen Township that the problem at the dam has been resolved and that residents may return to their homes.
