Judy called the meeting to order at 7:00p.m.

Minutes

The Chairman noted that the minutes of October 9, 2014 were approved as corrected.

Treasurer's Report

Dolores put a check request in for all of the items purchased for the Plank House.

The CCHS membership still has to be paid. Dolores told Jon Altshul that the remaining \$1000.00 will be used for a floorcloth. She is still looking for a vendor.

Judy feels some chairs in the parlor need maintenance or replacement.

Dolores picked up items for the sewing table, i.e. embroidery hoop made of bone.

Planning for 2015 - Ellen has some sutlers (which sell merchandise to re-enactors) who are interested in Living History Day on June 6, 2015, but are waiting for the Continental Line dates. The Commission would also like to have militia and demonstrators. The fence is supposed to be replaced. If it isn't ready by June 6, then the Commission would like to have it removed. Maintenance – Ellen reported that the quilt frame will be fixed and the floors in the Plank House will be done during the winter. Dolores has to paint the clock shelf. Kathryn mentioned that the springhouses need some maintenance.

2 **Misc Research** – Ed has completed the project for Karen Marshall. He is working on a 1777
3 map of East Goshen showing property owners and roads at that time. He is thinking of making a
4 map for 1817 to use at the bicentennial in 2017. Kathryn suggested making puzzles of the map
5 for the children.

8 **Historic Properties Inventory** – Judy suggested that Chris give the list of houses on the final
9 historic list to Ed. She thinks there were 12 during the Battle of the Clouds. The files need to be
10 reviewed for accuracy.

12 **Quilting** – Dolores and Judy had samples of the quilting they made. Linda Hicks told Dolores
13 she would give assistance with quilting. Dolores will call the Spinning Wheel to set a date for
14 training. Cost is \$60/person.

17 Kathryn mentioned that the Network found a document that has guidelines to help you decide
18 what to keep or not.

19 Jennine Spears of the CCPC came to the Network and spoke about removal of properties from
20 historic lists.

21 National History Day – 2/28 is judges training; 3/21 is high schools and 3/22 is middle schools.
22 They need judges. You can sign up on the website.

23 Norm Glass has a written list of what he donated as a permanent loan.

24 The barn on Paoli Pike across from the Sunoco station was demolished. Dolores recalled that the
25 owners came to the HC and said they wanted to take it down. Mark Gordon took photos.
