[Central Chester County Bicycle and Pedestrian Plan \(2013\)](#)

The Central Chester County Bicycle and Pedestrian Plan (2013) was developed by the Chester County Planning Commission for seven municipalities, including East Goshen. Maps on pages 66 and 67 depict bicycle and pedestrian improvements in East Goshen and along the Paoli Pike Corridor. These maps show potential future connections to the west using a combination of sidewalks, on-road bicycle facilities, and multi-use trails from the Paoli Pike corridor in East Goshen to West Goshen Township, West Chester Borough, and destinations beyond.

The Patriots Path Evaluation (2007) was developed by the Chester County Planning Commission to evaluate the viability of providing a pedestrian route between Valley Forge Park and the Paoli Massacre sites, with connections to other historically significant landmarks. Subsequently, Malvern Borough, East Whiteland Township, and Tredyffrin Township developed the more detailed Patriots Path Plan (2010). The Overview Map of the Plan shows potential connections between Malvern Borough and the Chester Valley Trail. The municipalities are continuing to work together to implement the Patriots Path.

Willistown Township and Malvern Borough undertook the Greenway Master Plan (2013) to identify connections between exceptional historic, recreational, open space, and community assets of the Borough and northern Willistown. The Phase I Map identifies a proposed greenway along Paoli Pike between Warren Avenue and Sugartown Road with connections to the Borough along both Sugartown Road and Warren Avenue.
