The meeting was called to order by Chairman Joe Zulli at 7 7:00 pm. 8 9 Commission members present were: Christine Taraborelli 10 11 Ann Marie Fletcher-Moore 12 Betsy Williams PJ Viloski 13 Daria Chapman 14 15 Ed Coyle Others present were: 16 17 Jason Lang, Director of Recreation 18 19 CALL TO ORDER/PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE Joe led the Pledge of Allegiance. 20 21 Joe asked for a moment of silence to remember our troops & veterans. 22 Joe asked if anyone would be recording the meeting. There was no response. 23 24 APPROVAL OF MINUTES 1. Joe noted that the minutes of the August 8, 2015 meeting were approved. 25 26 27 CHAIRMAN'S REPORT Joe thanked Jason for all he did this summer. 28 29 30 **NEW BUSINESS** 1. Community Day Review - Community Day, held on Saturday August 29, 2015, was very well 31 32 attended. Jason is waiting for the estimated number from the police department. There were 50-60 volunteers. 33 Jason sent out a survey. So far 70 people have responded with 95% selecting excellent or very good. 75% want 34 Community Day in August rather that June because the fireworks start at 8 pm instead of 9 pm or later. Food trucks were discussed and suggestion made to have a drink stand. The 501c3 raised \$32,000 for the event. 35 October 17, 2015 – Pumpkin Festival from 10 – 11 am. Also this year from 8 – 12am will be the 1st 36 37 Annual Pumpkin Bowl to benefit PA Wounded Warriors. Jason needs volunteers and referees. He has contacted 38 ACAC, WEGO, YMCA & Goshen Fire Co for possible teams. Tree Placement – The Park Commission will be receiving 21 trees from a developer who had to 39 40 remove trees. The Commission agreed with Jason's plan to place them in Applebrook Park. 41 **OLD BUSINESS** 42 1. East Goshen Park Master Plan – The Board of Supervisors selected Tom Committa as consultant for this 43 plan. The committee consists of the Park & Rec Commission members, Jason, Carmen Battavio and Public Works. 44 Tom suggested the 3rd Thursdays (9/17, 10/15, 11/19 & 12/17) as possible meeting dates. Joe feels kids can give 45 good ideas. PJ suggested a presentation at East Goshen Elementary school. The Commission agreed that, if any of 46 47 the current items in the park can be recycled, they should be. 48 2. Open Space & Rec Plan – Joe reported that the final draft is going through the approval process and is 49 on the Township website. 3. Paoli Pike Trail – They had their 2nd meeting the end of August. This is for a feasibility study. If it is 50 approved, then engineering plans, grants, permits, etc. will start. There will be an open house for the public at 6:30 51 52 pm before the BOS meeting. 53 54 55

1. Jason provided an End of the Summer Report covering January to August 2015.
