10 Call to Order

11 Chairman Thomas Kilburn called the meeting to order. The Committee began with the Pledge of  
12 Allegiance and there was a moment of silence for our military troops.

14 Goshen Village Shopping Center

15 Luann Petrellis and Senya Isayeff know owners of a couple of restaurants who might be interested in  
16 looking at the Goshen Village Shopping Center for a restaurant location. They will try to follow up with  
17 the restaurant owners. Senya Isayeff mentioned that East Goshen Township is a “dry” township and it is  
18 important that the Township put the liquor license referendum on the ballot for the Township to be  
19 approved for selling alcohol. Senya Isayeff also reported to the Committee that Dunkin Donuts has  
20 gotten approval to move into the old Citadel Bank Building in the Goshen Village Shopping Center. They  
21 hope to open the new store by February 2016. He also announced that the Paoli Pike Trail Committee  
22 had an open house to present the Paoli Pike Trail Feasibility Study and Master Plan prior to the Board of  
23 Supervisors Meeting.

25 Proposal to change the name of East Goshen to Goshenville

26 The Futurist Committee proposes that steps be taken to enable changing East Goshen to Goshenville  
27 Township. The name of the Township will identify with our history and culture; instilling pride in the  
28 people that live here. Goshenville was organized 1704. Goshenville was settled by Welsh Quaker  
29 families who had journeyed to America seeking freedom of religion. This will enable the Township to  
30 link with strategic goals of the comprehensive plan with the name change and we will gain recognition  
31 and image that we are a premier Chester County community. Rogers Vaughn told the Committee that  
32 the proposal should be submitted with five strategic goals. By presenting the goals in the proposal it will  
33 help attract families for the future.
