Dear Resident:

As you are aware Sunoco Pipeline is undertaking a project called Mariner East 2. Mariner East 2 involves the construction of a 20 inch pipeline and possibly a second 16 inch pipeline that would be used to transport natural gas liquids such as propane, ethane and butane from the western part of the state to Marcus Hook, Pennsylvania.

Within the limits of East Goshen Township, the proposed pipelines will run from the intersection of Boot Road & Greenhill Road, south along Boot Road to its intersection with North Chester Road, then south along North Chester Road to the Township Boundary at Manley Road.

Pursuant to a request by the Board of Supervisors, representatives of Sunoco Pipeline will attend the Board of Supervisors meeting on Tuesday February 23, 2016 at 7:00 PM to update Township residents and businesses that reside or operate a business along the proposed route about the project. This will be the only item on the agenda and I would encourage you to attend if you have any questions about the Mariner East 2 project.
