Call to Order

Ellen called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

Pledge of Allegiance & Moment of Silence

Ellen led those present in the Pledge of Allegiance, then asked all present for a moment of silence to remember those who serve in our military.

Minutes

Minutes of February 11, 2016 were approved as corrected.

Treasurer's Report

Montajejan reported that she submitted the receipts for Dolores and request for check to CCHPN for the workshop. Chris mentioned that the check for CCHPN is being returned. Since East Goshen is a member we don't have to pay for Commission members to attend. Also, he mentioned that the date of the workshop is changed from March 12 to April 16. He will not be able to attend on the new date

Old Business

Historical Resources Update – Ed provided copies of his report on 1601 Paoli Pike and Griffith Owen the original owner.

Also he gave everyone a copy of an email from resident Baxter Wellmon addressing the Milltown Dam and providing some history of it.

When Ed researched the spring house in Applebrook by the Chamber of Commerce building, he found that they weren't listed in the deeds until 1829. Joseph Garret was the owner.

Line Drawings – Ed had a brochure from Las Vegas, NM that had line drawings of their historic homes in it. A discussion of the historic homes and ways to acknowledge them followed.

4 a. Artisan's Fair June 4, 2016 – Ellen reported that some more vendors are
5 coming. Chris verified that the plaque for Ben will be put in the Blacksmith Shop.

6 b. Historic Properties update – Judy reported that she is still organizing the files
7 to scan.

8 c. Historic Preservation Standards – Chris is making files for the Historic Ordinance.
9 He will ask Monica Close to attend the May meeting to discuss this project. He
10 will also contact Karen Marshall to come and tell us what other municipalities are doing.
11 Carmen explained that the current rules are very old and need to be updated.

14 1. Judy reported that the quilt is almost done. She and Dolores selected some
15 medallions to use on the edge.

16 2. Ed spoke with Cliff who is almost done his work on the 1817 map.

19 NEW BUSINESS

20 Volunteers – It was decided to be open in May & June and September & October, Saturdays
21 from 10:00 am to 2:00 pm. Montajeau volunteered to put together a schedule
22 for summer tours. She will also contact volunteers. Ellen mentioned that the grant they
23 were considering requires 100 days/year for the buildings to be open so we wouldn't
24 qualify. Carmen asked about attendance on Saturdays. Chris and Montajeau said it is
25 enough to make it worthwhile. A minimum of 2 volunteers is needed, 1 in the Plank
26 House and 1 in the Blacksmith Shop. Ellen mentioned that signs are needed on Paoli
27 Pike the days we are open. It was suggested to use the Township electronic signs and
28 maybe put an additional sign in front of the Township Building.

30 Training & Clean Up Day - Chris mentioned that April 30 is training and clean up day at
31 the Historic area. Chris feels the window frames need to be replaced in the Plank
32 House. He will make a list of items that need attention then walk through with Mark
33 Miller.

35 School Reunion – Toby is still waiting for input from residents who might be interested.

37 New Neighbor Program - Chris suggested starting a new neighbor program to welcome
38 new owners of historic homes. Many people associate the Historic Commission with
39 the HARB in West Chester.

9 Board of Supervisors – Carmen reported that WEGO Police Department is going
10 through the process to get accreditation from the PA Board. They check everything and
11 require massive training of the officers. It is complex and looks like it will come through
12 in March. This will help lower insurance premiums, with public outreach and morale of
13 the officers. They are currently hiring part-time officers and trying to move current part-
14 timers to fulltime.

15 The BOS viewed a slide presentation of the Park Master Plan and approved it.

16 On March 22 there will be a meeting at the Goshen Fire Company on Park Ave. about
17 the Milltown Dam. The engineers report is on the website.

20 Judy mentioned that the owner of the one Historic house in Bow Tree has a file of histo-
21 ry about the house. Chris wants to meet with him.
