## 2 EAST GOSHEN TOWNSHIP 3 CONSERVANCY BOARD MEETING 4 April 13, 2016 5 7:00 P.M. 6 7 The East Goshen Township Conservancy Board met for their regularly scheduled meeting on Wednesday, April 8 13, 2016 at the East Goshen Township Building. Board members present were: Chairman Sandra Snyder, Patti 9 Brown, Walter Wujcik, Erich Meyer, Scott Sanders, John Scheidt and Andy Tyler. Others present were: Janet Emanuel, Township Supervisor. 10 11 12 CALL TO ORDER Sandy called the meeting to order at 7:00pm. 13 14 15 PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE Sandy led the Pledge of Allegiance and a moment of silence to remember our troops and first 16 17 responders. 18 19 APPROVAL OF MINUTES Sandy noted that the minutes of the March 9, 2016 meeting were approved. 20 21 **NEW BUSINESS** 22 1. 2016 Keep East Goshen Beautiful Day – Unfortunately this event had to be cancelled twice because 23 of bad weather. Walter commented that it was held in April because the ticks and poison plants aren't 24 out yet. It was decided to have it on Sat. April 30, with rain date Sunday May 1. 25 2. Projects for Boy Scouts – Scott found some boy scouts who need projects. Andy mentioned that he 26 has day lilies that he wants to pull out at his home. Maybe the scouts could do this and plant them 27 28 somewhere else in the township. He will get the species and contact Mark Miller. Sandy mentioned another maintenance project of cleaning the blue bird boxes. 29 3. WEEDS Inc – Sandy will email Brian O'Neal for his cost this year to spray in the spring and fall. 30 Walter noticed multi flora is growing in Clymers Woods. Sandy will ask Brian to look at it. Scott 31 feels Clymers Woods should be mulched. 32 4. Serpentine Belt – Sandy explained that algae grow on the serpentine rocks. They Board needs to 33 locate it and maintain it so it sustains the ecosystem. Janet mentioned that when they were planning 34 Wellington they planned it so it would not impact the serpentine that is there. The Board decided to do 35 36 a site walk on Saturday, May 14, 9:00 am meet at the Veterans Pavilion in East Goshen Park. 37 **OLD BUSINESS** 38 1. Trees – Ten trees were received from Potters Nursery. Public Works planted 9 on E. Boot Road and 39 40 1 in the park. Scott reviewed the original agreement with Potters which was to get a letter from the Friends of East Goshen acknowledging the trees at \$50 each. Scott asked Jon Altshul for a letter from 41 the Friends. He got an email back stating that they couldn't because the Friends didn't take possession 42 of the trees. After discussion, Janet encouraged the Board to look into this further. Someone should put 43 the process in writing and give it to the ABCs. 44 45 LIAISON REPORTS 46 1. Board of Supervisors – Janet reported that the BOS approved a proposal from J Flemming to do 47 48 testing on the sediment in the reservoir. If there are metals, then they have to identify the contaminated 49 areas. Their choices are repair, partial breach or full breach. Scott mentioned that the riparian buffer along Reservoir Road was cut down to the water's edge. When he asked about it, Rick told him that 50 some of the residents wanted a better view of the water. Sandy commented that the Township ordinance 51 52 requires a buffer. Scott made a motion for Sandy to write a letter to the Board of Supervisors. John seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously. 53
