Minutes

The minutes of the June 8, 2016 meeting were approved as corrected.

New Business

1. Scott wrote an article about Red Oak Blight, CB 7-13-16 Draft.docx which will be submitted for the next newsletter.
2. 2017 Budget - The budget for 2016 was \$6,300 only \$63.00 was spent. A Fall planting was discussed. Scott will get a package from Shemin Nursery. A work force will be needed. Scott discussed having an Eagle Scout assist. Erich mentioned that Clymer's Woods needs a few replacement trees. Other areas for possible plantings were around the Township building and around the dam when breached. It was decided to keep the budget at \$6,300 and maintain the 2016 balance to reforest the dam area.
3. Clymer's Woods may need to be trimmed in certain places. Scott will take a look at it and make a recommendation to Mark Miller.
