Present

Chairman, Thomas Kilburn, and Vice- Chairman Rogers Vaughn were present. Members, Luann Perellis and Brian Giresi were absent.

Call to Order

Chairman, Thomas Kilburn called the meeting to order. The Committee began the meeting with Pledge of Allegiance and there was a moment of silence for our military troops and first responders.

Approval of Minutes

Thomas Kilburn gave his recommendation that the 2016 September minutes be approved. Rogers Vaughn seconded the motion and the minutes were approved by the Committee.

Community Update Project

Rogers Vaughn said that there are 6,554 residences in East Goshen Township. There are about 1,336 Townhouse/Condo units in the area along West Chester Pike. There are 9 apartment complexes in East Goshen Township which include: Rosehill, New Kent, Waterview, Racquet Club, Treetops, Metropolitan of East Goshen, Oxford Gateway and Ridgewood. Hershey's Mill has about 1,720 units. If the area of Applebrook is included 40% of the residences would live in multi-family units. Mr. Kilburn said that with the earned income tax the Township would get a better tax base with a multi-family unit zoned area. The Futurist Committee plans to put an article in the Township Newsletter to give township residents an update on the future goals of the Township.

Township Trail System

Mr. Kilburn and Mr. Vaughn discussed how the neighborhoods which are next to the proposed Township Trail could hook up to Trail that will be built along Paoli Pike. This would include Bow Tree, Applebook, Vista Farms and Clocktower Woods. If homeowners associations were contacted it would help get the people interested in the trail system.

2017 Budget Request

Mr. Kilburn will submit the Futurist Committee 2017 budget request to Jon Altshul this week.
