1 EAST GOSHEN TOWNSHIP 2 MILLTOWN DAM COMMITTEE 3 1580 PAOLI PIKE 4 **NOVEMBER 9, 2016 – 7:00 pm** 5 **DRAFT MINUTES** 6 7 **Present:** 8 Paul Knox, Mike Lehmicke, Glenn Artman, Vince "Mick" McInnis, Dana Pizarro, Dave Hewett 9 and Chuck Hepler 10 Also in attendance were Board of Supervisors Vice-Chair Marty Shane, Township Manager Rick 11 12 Smith, and Hershey Mill Dam Committee Chair Wayne Hall. 13 14 Call to order & Pledge of Allegiance: Mike called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm and lead the assembly in the Pledge of Allegiance. 15 16 17 **Moment of Silence:** 18 Rick called for a moment of silence to honor the members of the military who defend our 19 country. 20 21 Minutes: Rick distributed a copy of Peter Simone's comments from the November 2, 2016 meeting and 22 suggested that they be attached to the meeting minutes. 23 24 25 Mick motioned to approve the minutes of the November 2, 2016 meeting; the motion was 26 seconded by Glenn and approved unanimously. 27 28 **Old Business:** 29 Glenn asked it the Committee would consider including recommendations for something that extended beyond the Milltown Dam property. It was the consensus of the members that they 30 31 could and would if it was related to the project. 32 33 **New Business:** 34 The members discussed Peter Simone's comment that the area should be a "passive recreational facility". Rick advised that the terms "active" and "passive" concerns how the activity is 35 conducted. He cited by way of example in a "passive" recreation area a family could play a pick-36 up baseball game. However, an organized little league baseball game would be limited to an 37 "active" recreation area. 38 39 40 The members identified the following opportunities and restrictions that exist for the site. 41 42 • Fishing Ponds • Controlling sediment 43 44 • Trails (paved or unpaved) • Parking area (the location and number of cars) 45
