**Paoli Pike Corridor Master Plan:**

Natasha outlined the project overview, scope, role of the committee and the project schedule that the Consultant team has developed.

Natasha then presented a draft of the vision and goals for the plan:

***Make Paoli Pike a Destination***

- Connect people to the Paoli Pike Trail and other places along the Corridor to support alternative modes of transportation and expand opportunities for recreation

- 1 • Calm traffic along the Paoli Pike Corridor to create a safe and comfortable environmental for  
2 walking, biking, and driving
- 3 • Enhance the Town Center to support commerce and promote compact, mixed-use, walkable  
4 development with appropriate amenities.

6 Based on the discussion at the Committee Meeting, the following goal statement was added for the  
7 presentation to the Board of Supervisors:

- 8 • Activate the corridor through programs and community events to encourage people to walk, bike,  
9 eat, shop, and play along Paoli Pike

10  
11 **Neighborhood Connections:**

12 **Bicycle, Pedestrian and Crosswalk Facilities Toolboxes**– Natasha discussed the various types of  
13 facilities and options to provide safety throughout the corridor for pedestrians and bicyclists with the  
14 committee.

15 The Committee discussed several proposed draft neighborhood connection alignments and the  
16 evaluation criteria to use for selecting priority connections for this plan.

17 The Committee prioritized the following neighborhood connections for further conceptual design:

- 18 1. Reservoir Road – North from Paoli Pike to enterprise drive and south from Paoli Pike to Cooper  
19 Circle.
- 20 2. Boot Road – south from Paoli Pike to Barker Circle.
- 21 3. Bow Tree Connection – Pedestrian bridge over Ridley Creek to Blacksmith House trail head.

22 Numerous other future neighborhood connections were discussed in detail.

24 **Traffic Calming:**

25 **Traffic Calming Toolbox:** Natasha discussed the various types of traffic calming options available to  
26 use throughout the corridor with the committee.

27 Priority traffic calming areas along the Paoli Pike corridor are:

- 28 1. Airport Road and Ellis Ln.
- 29 2. Township Park Entrances
- 30 3. Line Rd.

32 **Alternative Features of Goshenville (Town Center):**

33 TCA presented two concept plans for park like enhancements to the triangle parcel at the intersection of  
34 Paoli Pike and Boot Rd. to the committee (triangle Park Concept Plan 1 and 2). TCA also presented a  
35 concept plan for a sitting area along the Paoli Pike Trail adjacent to the Goshen Village Shopping center  
36 (Promenade Plaza concept plan).
