The minutes are approved as corrected. 26 Old Business: None 27 **New Business:** Selection of a Committee Vice Chair: Mary Urbine was nominated as Vice Chairman for the committee, 28 29 the nomination was seconded and the vote was unanimous. 30 <u>Planning Consultant Proposals:</u> The Committee received one (1) planning consultant proposal as a 31 result of the RFP process; McMahon Associates Inc. in association with Thomas Committa Associates 32 Inc. Mr. Gordon presented the committee with his memo outlining the staff analysis of the proposal 33 with the standards of the RFP. The committee discussed the proposal, the specific tasks and 34 deliverables outlined in the proposal. Mr. Vaughn expressed his desire and that of the Futurist Committee (FC) for the Corridor Master Plan to deliver streetscape and architectural renderings for 35 36 future development along the corridor. Mr. Gordon noted that streetscape design guidelines are included 37 in the McMahon scope of work, Task 5. Architectural renderings were not specified as an element of 38 the plan however Mr. Gordon suggested that the Committee discuss this with the consultant to see if it is 39 possible to explore this during the planning process. Mr. Vaughn also mentioned that the FC supports 40 identifying a "Unique Feel" for East Goshen in order to "Differentiate" itself from the rest of 41 surrounding West Chester municipalities. Ms. Emanuel explained the challenges of being a developed 42 community and making significant changes to Zoning and permitted land uses along the corridor: 43 however she agreed that within the Town Center area, design guidelines make sense for future 44 development and redevelopment. Ms. Kier made a motion to recommend that the Board of Supervisors accept the McMahon proposal as 45 46 outlined in Mr. Gordon's memo. 47
