Call to Order

Sandy called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

Sandy led those present in the Pledge of Allegiance and then asked for a moment of silence to remember those who serve in our military and our first responders.

Minutes

The minutes of the November 9, 2016 meeting were approved as corrected.

Goals

2016 goals and accomplishments were discussed. They located the serpentine rock in the parks, worked with Mark Miller to get mowing done in Clymers Woods the way they wanted, and wood chips were delivered to Clymers Woods to be distributed in the Spring.

5. Keep East Goshen Beautiful Day will be Sat., April 22, 2017 – Earth Day.
6. Bat Houses – Install more to help with insect control.

Fall Planting – Erich reported that the PA One Call wouldn't allow planting of trees in Clymers because of a pipeline that goes along Line Road. So, the 18 trees were planted along E. Boot Road.
