Ed would like input from Mark Miller. Joe asked if the public is using it. Dan answered not until there is a lockbox for the stones.

New Playground - Jason reported that the Township engineer's report was received. It will go to the manufacturer to select the equipment and then to DCNR for final approval. He anticipates work will start in September – 2 weeks for demo and 2 weeks for construction.

- <u>Bicentennial Celebration</u> Jason reviewed the schedule and provided maps showing the parade route, the food trucks spots, the stages, and shifts for volunteers. There will be 4 elected officials.
- NRPA Gold Medal Award Jason reported that East Goshen did not make it into the top 4 of this national award. They don't give a full list but based on information he did receive, Jason feels we were very close.
