# <u>ORDER</u>

AND NOW, this 25<sup>th</sup> day of July, 2017, following two conference calls during which the parties presented extensive argument in support of their respective positions, it is hereby ordered that the Appellants' application for a temporary partial supersedeas is **granted**. The permits that are the subject of this appeal are hereby superseded effective immediately to the extent they authorize the Permittee to conduct horizontal directional drilling. However, this Order may be modified in part if the Permittee provides the Board with detailed affidavits explaining why it would cause equipment damage, a safety issue, or more environmental harm than good to stop drilling at the 55 locations where drilling is actively underway. This temporary partial supersedeas shall expire at 9:00 a.m. on August 7, 2017, unless further extended by the Board. The hearing on the Appellants' petition for a partial supersedeas shall commence in the Board's Harrisburg hearing room on the date requested by the parties; namely, **9:00 a.m.** on **August 7, 2017**.

# SUNOCO PIPELINE, L.P.'s VERIFIED FIRST EMERGENCY MOTION FOR CLARIFICATION OF THE JULY 25, 2017 ORDER

Permittee Sunoco Pipeline, L.P. ("SPLP"), by its undersigned counsel, requests that the Board provide clarification of its July 25, 2017 Order (the "Order") granting Appellants' application for a temporary partial supersedeas of the permits that are the subject of this appeal, to the extent that they authorize SPLP to use horizontal directional drilling ("HDD"), and avers as follows:

1. To safeguard equipment contained within drill holes, it is necessary to periodically rotate the drill bits and reamers and move the drill bits and reamers approximately 30 feet back and forth within the bore holes. If this safeguarding procedure is not performed, there is a substantial likelihood that the drill bits and reamers will seize, which will result in loss of the drilling equipment and the drill holes.

2. These activities will cause no advancement of the drill holes.

3. The foregoing activities do not constitute horizontal directional drilling, but SPLP

seeks clarification of the Board's Order to ensure that this limited activity is permitted under the

Order.

4. SPLP seeks to perform the foregoing at the HDD locations identified in the list

attached as Exhibit "1."

5. Pursuant to the Board's Order, we intend to file a motion expeditiously seeking to

modify in part the Board's Order, accompanied by detailed affidavits that explain why it would

cause equipment damage, a safety issue, or more environmental harm than good to stop drilling

at certain of the HDD locations where drilling was actively underway prior to issuance of the

Board's Order.

WHEREFORE, for the foregoing reasons, SPLP requests that the Board clarify the July

25, 2017 Order, to make clear that the Order does not prevent SPLP from periodically rotating

the drill bits or reamers in existing drill holes and moving the drill bits or reamers back and forth

within the bore holes without advancing the length of the bore holes, in order to safeguard the

integrity of the downhole equipment, and enter an order in the form submitted herewith.
