The Committee began the meeting with the 12 Pledge of allegiance and there was a moment of silence for our military troops and first responders. 13 14 **Approval of Minutes** 15 Thomas Kilburn asked for the approval for the December 18, 2017 minutes. Rogers Vaughn seconded 16 the motion and the minutes were approved by the entire Futurist Committee. 17 18 **Paoli Pike Corridor Master Plan** 19 Zoning Officer, Mark Gordon gave the Futurist Committee members a copy of the Paoli Pike Master Plan 20 which was adopted December 19, 2017. Mr. Gordon gave a project overview of the Paoli Pike Master 21 Plan and answered questions that the Committee's members had. The items that were brought up 22 were: 23 (1) Traffic Calming – This would improve better gateways along Paoli Pike to Airport Road, Line 24 Road and within the Town Center. 25 (2) Community Connections- Bicycle and pedestrian facilities to connect to local communities along Paoli Pike. 26 27 (3) Streetscape-This would be consistent streetscape on Paoli Pike between Boot Road and Route 28 352, this would include lighting, proper landscaping. 29 (4) Signage- Consistent signage that would give identity to East Goshen Township. 30 (5) Project Schedule- A project schedule was included with the Paoli Pike Master Plan 31 (6) Enhance Goshenville- This would include new ideas for building locations, building heights, and 32 parking locations. Other ideas could include having food trucks at different sites in the 33 Goshenville shopping center.
