**Present**

**Call to Order**

Chairman Thomas Kilburn called the meeting to order. The Committee began the meeting with the Pledge of allegiance and there was a moment of silence for our military troops and first responders.

**Approval of Minutes**

Thomas Kilburn asked for the approval for the December 18, 2017 minutes. Rogers Vaughn seconded the motion and the minutes were approved by the entire Futurist Committee.

**Paoli Pike Corridor Master Plan**

Zoning Officer, Mark Gordon gave the Futurist Committee members a copy of the Paoli Pike Master Plan which was adopted December 19, 2017. Mr. Gordon gave a project overview of the Paoli Pike Master Plan and answered questions that the Committee's members had. The items that were brought up were:

- (1) Traffic Calming – This would improve better gateways along Paoli Pike to Airport Road, Line Road and within the Town Center.
- (2) Community Connections- Bicycle and pedestrian facilities to connect to local communities along Paoli Pike.
- (3) Streetscape-This would be consistent streetscape on Paoli Pike between Boot Road and Route 352, this would include lighting, proper landscaping.
- (4) Signage- Consistent signage that would give identity to East Goshen Township.
- (5) Project Schedule- A project schedule was included with the Paoli Pike Master Plan
- (6) Enhance Goshenville- This would include new ideas for building locations, building heights, and parking locations. Other ideas could include having food trucks at different sites in the Goshenville shopping center. Mixed use development that would include outdoor gathering spaces and dining.

**Municipal Governments in an Aging Community**

Tom Kilburn told the Committee that they would discuss governments in an aging community at the February meeting.
