The meeting was called to order and the minutes were approved

Jon Altshul briefed the committee on plans for a branding plan for EGT. The committee supported Jon's plan for developing this plan which includes getting proposals from professional groups with experience in this area.

Rod briefed the committee on the meeting he attended with Giant representatives about their plans to sponsor a referendum on liquor sales in East Goshen. 2900 signatures of registered voters are required to get the referendum on the May 15 primary ballot and Giant representatives are canvassing and obtaining these signatures at their stores. The Futurist Committee supports this referendum as our research indicates that if alcohol sales are allowed in restaurants, investors will be more interested in developing the Town Center, a key goal for our committee.

Brad briefed the group on plans for a Town Center overlay and possible changes to residential zoning for any new development in the township.
