In attendance were: 9 Chairman Chuck Proctor, Kelly Bidegary, Kathleen Lynch and new member Ted Roberts. Others in attendance: Mark Gordon, Township Zoning Officer. 10 11 12 <u>Call to Order</u> – Chuck called the meeting to order. 13 14 Pledge of Allegiance - Chuck led the Pledge of Allegiance and asked for a moment of 15 silence for our military and first responders. 16 17 **New Business** 18 a. Chuck welcomed new Commission member Ted Roberts. Ted has been a resident 19 of East Goshen for 25 years. He owns the historic property known as the Three Tun Tavern. 20 He has 3 children and works in the tech industry. 21 22 b. 2019 Budget - Chuck explained what the budget does and does not cover. Ted 23 wondered if the HC could be self-sufficient; i.e. sell ornaments. The 1st year would have the Blacksmith Shop on it. Then each year a different asset would be on it. Chuck explained 24 25 that there is a Friends of East Goshen, which is a 501 (c) 3 organization. Ted also suggested that there should be a plaque program for display on the historic properties. Mark provided 26 27 a printout of the 103 historic assets. There may be grants to cover some of the cost. Ted 28 commented that 1 plaque could be given every quarter of the year so they can be featured in 29 the Township newsletter. Mark suggested awarding some; i.e. the Smith house at the 30 Metropolitan apartments was renovated to a commercial use and preserved. Ted suggested 31 making the plaques in the East Goshen Blacksmith shop. 32 Ted moved to request the same budget as 2018 totaling \$2,695.00. Kelly seconded the 33 motion. The motion passed unanimously. 34 35 Minutes 36 The minutes of the May 10, 2018 meeting were approved. 37 38 **Any Other Matter** 39 2019 Goals - Chuck explained that in January at the annual ABC meeting he has to present 40 the Commission's goals for 2019. He will use the following action points: 41 1. Plaque program 42 2. Ornaments 43 3. Meeting with owners of historic assets 44 4. Provide a questionnaire for owners 45 5. Meet with Historic Commissions from surrounding townships 46 6. Meet with the Chester County Historic Commission 47 7. Revise the property inventory report 48 8. Add the Sullivan House to the asset inventory

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9. Add some more members to the Commission
