Dear Property Owner:

The purpose of this letter is to inform you that the East Goshen Township Board of Supervisors will hold a special meeting to discuss a draft Zoning Ordinance under consideration by the Board of Supervisors.

This draft zoning ordinance amendment, titled "Open space development", will amend the existing "Single family open space development" ordinance by providing two additional development options for residential properties which are 20 acres or larger and located within the R-2 zoning district.

These development options will facilitate the preservation of open space, cultural and historic resources, and environmentally sensitive areas. The ordinance includes detailed open space and building design standards for the new dwelling unit types.

The new development options presented for consideration in the draft ordinance are:

- 1. Twins (semi-detached dwelling units) or any combination of twins and singles, with 60% of the lot area dedicated to open space, and a maximum of 1 dwelling unit per acre.
- 2. Triplexes (Townhouses with a maximum of three dwelling units per building) or any combination of triplexes, twins and singles, with 65% of the lot area dedicated to open space, and a maximum of 1 dwelling unit per acre.

You are receiving this letter because your property is located within 1000 feet of one of the properties that could be affected by these recommendations. The Board invites all interested parties to attend the meeting, listen to the presentation, and ask questions.

The Board will hold this special meeting on **Tuesday**, **January 22, 2019 at 7 pm.** The meeting will be held at **East High School**, **in the Auditorium**, which is located at 450 Ellis Ln., West Chester PA, 19380. The draft zoning ordinance amendment can be found on the "Latest News" section of the Township website; <u>www.eastgoshen.org</u>. Conceptual plans representing these development types are being developed at this time and will be available on the website prior to the meeting.

Net of pass-through accounts, as of November 30th, the general fund had revenues of \$9,525,503 and expenses of \$9,436,476 for a year-to-date surplus of \$89,030. Compared to the YTD budget, revenues were \$72,997 over budget and expenses were \$237,527 under budget for a positive budget variance of \$310,524. As of November 30th, the general fund balance was \$5,350,577.

On the expense side, Emergency Services, Public Works and Administration are all under budget, while Codes (-\$2,735, due to higher-than-budgeted Zoning Consultant expenses) and Parks and Recreation (-\$113,035, due to cost overruns for the Marydell Pond Rehabilitation project) are both over-budget.

On the revenue side, Real Estate Transfer Tax (+\$151,896), Real Estate Property Tax (+\$19,139) and Other Income (i.e. Interest; +\$34,028) continue to perform strongly. Local Services Tax (-\$10,360), Earned Income Tax (-\$158,047), and Cable Franchise Fees (-\$30,627) all under-performed relative to the budget. Notably, EIT, while under-budget, is still up slightly (<1%) from a year ago.

Other funds

- The **State Liquid Fuels Fund** had \$562,685 in revenues and \$0 expenses. The fund balance was \$563,187.
- The Capital Reserve Fund had \$629,809 in revenues and \$1,024,418 in expenses. The fund balance is \$5,629,423.
- The **Transportation Fund** had \$9,236 in revenues and \$863 in expenses. The fund balance is \$1,088,907.
- The **Sewer Operating Fund** had \$3,396,095 in revenues and \$2,996,611 in expenses. The fund balance is \$1,286,156.
- The **Refuse Fund** had \$1,095,822 in revenues and \$971,183 in expenses. The fund balance is \$738,768.
- The **Bond Fund** had \$107,654 in revenues and \$1,029,677 in expenses. The fund balance is \$6,414,300.
- The Sewer Capital Reserve Fund had \$35,369 in revenues and \$90,522 in expenses. The fund balance is \$2,107,526.
- The **Operating Reserve Fund** had \$35,077 in revenues and no expenses. The fund balance is \$2,539,432.

Year-End Projections

I am now projecting that the General Fund will finish the year with a surplus of \$2,973, a decrease of \$50,000 due to the overruns at Marydell. I have not changed the year-end projection for any other funds.

EAST GOSHEN TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS MEETING 1580 PAOLI PIKE TUESDAY, DECEMBER 4, 2018 FINAL APPROVED MINUTES

Present: Chairman Marty Shane; Vice-Chairman Carmen Battavio; Members David Shuey, Janet Emanuel and Mike Lynch; Township Manager Rick Smith; Assistant Township Manager and Finance Director Jon Altshul; Judy DiFonzo (Pipeline Task Force) and Erich Meyer (Conservancy Board)

Call to Order & Pledge of Allegiance

Marty called the meeting to order at 7:03 p.m. and led the pledge of allegiance.

Moment of Silence

Carmen called for a moment of silence to honor our troops and first responders, as well as the late President George Herbert Walker Bush.

Recording

The meeting was livestreamed on the Township's YouTube page.

Consider Fire Prevention Program

This matter was tabled pending further information.

<u>Consider Adoption of 2019 Budget, Approval of Staff Salaries and Adoption of 2019 Westtown East Goshen Police Budget</u>

Jon provided an overview of his November 29, 2018, memo outlining the changes to the budget since it was proposed on November 13th, including a reduction in the 2019 Earned Income Tax projection, \$3,000 for general expenses for both the Sustainability Committee and the Pipeline Task Force, and \$10,000 for grant assistance for the dams. Jon also mentioned that staff was recommending that the Township purchase Toyota Rav-4 Hybrids as replacement vehicles for the building inspectors instead of conventional fuel vehicles.

Carmen asked how much money would be retained in foreign countries by the purchase of a Toyota. Mike expressed concern about using fund balance to balance the budget.

David made a motion to adopt the 2019 East Goshen Township Budget for the General Fund, Pass Thru Accounts and Other Funds dated December 4, 2018; to adopt the 2019 Westtown East Goshen Police Budget Version 5, dated November 5, 2018 with revenues and expenses of \$7,684,126, of which East Goshen's share is \$3,811,235; to authorize Township staff to transfer \$151,279 from the East Goshen's Police Pension Trust to the Westtown-East Goshen Police Pension Plan to pay for East Goshen's share of the Additional Pension Plan Contribution line item

from this budget; and to approve 2019 Township staff salaries as proposed. Carmen seconded. The motion passed 5-0.

Chairman's Report

Marty made the following announcements:

- The Board met in Executive Session before tonight's meeting for a personnel matter.
- The U.S. Board of Geographic Names has approved the proposal to name the serpentine area in Hershey's Mill Village as the "Hershey's Mill Barrens".

Public Comment

Bernie Greenberg, 894 Jefferson Way, asked about the blow-down valve for the Adelphia pipeline. Rick explained that the existing valve is located on Paoli Pike, across the street from the Oriental Pearl. Adelphia needs to add a construction entrance to the valve station to add equipment at this location. Because the valve station is located in a wetland, DEP requires Adelphia to evaluate whether there are no viable alternatives to locating the construction entrance at that site. Mr. Greenberg also asked whether the 12 inch Mariner East line is now operational. Rick explained that Sunoco is not required to notify the Township about this. David stated that emergency services should be made aware when the line is operational, and Mike suggested that Rick reach out to the Chester County Department of Environmental Services about what they know.

Marty added that he has been asked to convene a public meeting with Adelphia, but that Adelphia has not expressed interest in participating. Rick noted that Adelphia's environmental assessment will be available on January 4th and that more information about the project will be known at that time. Bernie suggested that the Township request FERC that Adelphia be required to file an Environmental Impact Statement, which is more detailed than its Environmental Assessment. Rick agreed to follow up on this matter.

Lex Pavlo, 611 S. Speakman Lane, explained that the East Goshen Safety and Environmental Advocates has met with a number of elected state officials and is developing a list of legislative priorities around pipelines for them.

Approval of Minutes and Treasurer's Report

Janet made a motion to approve the minutes of November 20, 2018. Carmen seconded. The motion passed 5-0.

Carmen made a motion to approve the Treasurer's Report of November 29, 2018. David seconded. The motion passed 5-0.

Mike asked Jon to include the 2017 bonds on the debt service summary page.

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Consider Police Agreement

Rick explained that Westtown approved the inter-municipal partnership agreement with East Goshen for the operation of the Westtown East Goshen Police Department at its meeting last night. Janet made a motion to approve the Westtown East Goshen Police Agreement to take effect on January 1, 2019. Carmen seconded. Rick noted that the biggest change in the new agreement is that it puts the oversight responsibility for the department back under the purview of the Police Commission. The motion passed 5-0.

Consider Recommendation for Open Space Ordinance

Carmen made a motion to schedule a meeting for the presentation of the draft open space ordinance for January 22, 2019 and send out the appropriate 1,000 foot letter. Janet seconded. Marty explained that there will be mock ups of what development might look like at the Lewis property under the current ordinance compared with under the draft ordinance. The motion passed 5-0.

Jon suggested that given the cost of the wash bay and the fact that there is currently a \$1.2 million surplus beyond the value of the accumulated depreciation of all fixed assets in the Capital Reserve Fund that the wash bay be paid from the Capital Reserve Fund with no offsetting transfer from the General Fund. He argued that doing so could prevent a credit downgrade and delay the need for a tax increase for potentially two years. Carmen raised concerns that doing this would set a precedent.

Carmen made a motion to reject the bid from MccGenCon, Inc for non-compliance with the bid specifications and award the bid to F.W. Houder, Inc in the amount of \$593,648. Janet seconded. The motion passed 5-0.

Consider Proposal for Grant Assistance

Rick explained that the documentation for the Milltown and Hershey's Mill Dam grants requires a technical skill set that is beyond the Township's in-house capabilities and recommended contracting with Simone Collins for grant assistance. David made a motion to accept the November 26, 2018, proposal from Simone Collins with the condition that costs shall not exceed \$10,000 without the prior

approval of the Board. Janet seconded. The motion passed 4-0 (Mike had left the meeting).

Consider Petition to Intervene

Rick explained that seven area residents had filed a petition to intervene for emergency relief with the PUC to cease operation of the 8 inch Mariner East pipeline and prohibit operation of the workaround pipelines. He added that a motion was approved at the last Council of Governments meeting recommending that each municipality consider filing a motion to intervene in the complaint. David noted that this petition to intervene was materially similar, but not identical, to the petition filed by the Andover HOA and Senator Dinniman that has been stayed due to questions about Dinniman's standing in the matter. He added that the intent of the petition is to make Sunoco's emergency evacuation plans public.

Marty stated that he would like to read the complaint before he agrees to anything. Rick explained that we can also file a petition at a later time.

David made a motion for the Township to file sign on as an intervener to docket number C-2018-3006116 and P-2018-3006117, subject to our attorney's review. Carmen seconded.

Mr. Greenberg stated that we've been asking for an evacuation plan for many years now. Marty explained that it's impossible to know what any emergency response plan might look like because there are so many variables that could be at play. David observed that there's no communication strategy for residents located in any potential blast zone.

Ron Cocco, 633 N. Speakman Lane, stated that there's a perception that there's no clear evacuation plan in the event of a catastrophe. Rick noted that the petition is not about the County's emergency response plan, but about Sunoco's required public awareness plan.

The motion passed 4-0.

Any Other Matter

Rick explained that there were two agreements that the Township needed to enter into with Aqua and PECO related to the construction of the Paoli Pike Trail. Carmen clarified that Aqua would reimburse the Township for this work. Carmen made a motion to authorize the Chairman to execute the Aqua project agreement for the work to adjust castings within the project area and to approve Resolution 2018-183 to enter into a maintenance agreement with PennDOT for the new landscape median east of the intersection of Paoli Pike and North Chester Road. David seconded. The motion passed 4-0.

Liaison Reports

David reported that the Pipeline Task Force had its first meeting and has started to prioritize the issues that it will be focusing on, including legislation, communications and evacuation.

David made a motion to appoint Mary McCloskey to the Sustainability Committee. Janet seconded. The motion passed 4-0.

Marty reported that the Futurist Committee is concerned about what will happen after the streetscape work is complete.

Janet reported that the Planning Commission will be re-evaluating the overlay district at its next meeting.

Correspondence, Reports of Interest

Jon explained that we received the annual operational audit of Keystone Collections Group and that there were no material findings.

<u>Adjournment</u>

Janet made a motion to adjourn at 8:45. Carmen seconded. The motion passed 4-0.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE EAST GOSHEN TOWNSHIP ZONING ORDINANCE OF 1997, AS AMENDED, AT SECTION 240-56 AND 240-58 TO ADOPT **PROVISIONS MODIFYING** AND CLARIFYING TIME LIMITATIONS AND APPLICABLE **EXPIRATIONS** TO VARIANCES, APPEALS AND APPLICATIONS TO THE ZONING HEARING BOARD AND RELATED PERMITS.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of East Goshen Township, that the East Goshen Township Zoning Ordinance of 1997, as amended, which is codified in Chapter 240 of the East Goshen Township Code, titled, "Zoning", shall be amended as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 240-56.C shall be revised to read as follows:

"Where the subject matter of an application would ultimately constitute either a land development or a subdivision as both are defined in Section 107 of the Municipalities Planning Code, 53 P.S. Section 10107, the Zoning Hearing Board's approval shall be valid for a period of time consistent with the provisions of Section 917 of the Municipalities Planning Code, 53 P.S. Section 10917. If such approval does not involve or require land development and/or subdivision approval, such approval shall expire if the applicant fails to apply for a building permit or a use and occupancy permit, as the case may be, within eighteen (18) months from the date of the Zoning Hearing Board's approval. The Zoning Hearing Board may authorize an extension of time to obtain such permits, or to submit land development/subdivision plans, at the time of the hearing, or upon a future written request by the applicant which may be acted upon by the Zoning Hearing Board at a subsequent meeting of the Zoning Hearing Board."

SECTION 2. Section 240-58.D shall be revised to read as follows:

"Where the subject matter of a variance application would ultimately constitute either a land development or a subdivision as both are defined in Section 107 of the Municipalities Planning Code, 53 P.S. Section 10107, the Zoning Hearing Board's approval shall be valid for a period of time consistent with the provisions of Section 917 of the Municipalities Planning Code, 53 P.S. Section 10917. A variance approval that does not involve or require land development and/or subdivision approval shall

expire if the applicant fails to apply for a building permit or a use and occupancy permit, as the case may be, within eighteen (18) months from the date of the Zoning Hearing Board's approval. The Zoning Hearing Board may authorize an extension of time to obtain such permits, or to submit land development/subdivision plans, at the time of the hearing, or upon a future written request by the applicant which may be acted upon by the Zoning Hearing Board at a subsequent meeting of the Zoning Hearing Board."

SECTION 3. Severability. If any sentence, clause, section or part of this Ordinance is for any reason found to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such unconstitutionality, illegality or invalidity shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses, sections, or parts hereof. It is hereby declared as the intent of the Board of Supervisors that this Ordinance would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal or invalid sentence, clause, section or part thereof not been included herein.

<u>SECTION 4</u>. Repealer. All ordinances or parts of ordinances conflicting with any provision of this Ordinance are hereby repealed insofar as the same affects this Ordinance.

<u>SECTION 5.</u> Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective in five (5) days from the date of adoption.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF EAST GOSHEN, CHESTER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 129-B-2015 CODIFIED AS CHAPTER 153 OF THE EAST GOSHEN TOWNSHIP CODE, TITLED "MODEL AIRCRAFT AND AMATEUR ROCKETS".

WHEREAS, on October 12, 2018, the Governor of Pennsylvania signed into law Act 78 of 2018, which becomes effective January 10, 2019, and which preempts local regulations that attempt to regulate the use of unmanned aircraft; and

WHEREAS, on March 17, 2015, the Board of Supervisors of East Goshen Township adopted Ordinance No. 129-B-2015 to regulate the use of unmanned aircraft, including drones; and

WHEREAS, as a result of the adoption of Act 78 of 2018, it is necessary to repeal Ordinance No. 129-B-2015 which was codified in Chapter 153 of the East Goshen Township Code;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of East Goshen Township as follows:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 129-B-2015, as codified in Chapter 153 of the East Goshen Township Code, titled "Model Aircraft and Amateur Rockets" is repealed.

<u>SECTION 2.</u> <u>Severability.</u> The provisions of this Ordinance are severable, and if any article, section, subsection, clause, sentence or part thereof shall be held or declared illegal, invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, the decision shall not affect or impair any of the remaining articles, sections, subsections, clauses, sentences or parts thereof of this Ordinance. It is hereby declared to be the intent of the Board of Supervisors that this Ordinance would have been adopted if such illegal, invalid or unconstitutional article, section, subsection, clause, sentence or part thereof had not been included herein.

SECTION 3. Repealer. Ordinance No. 129-B-2015, as codified in Chapter 153 of the East Goshen Township Code, and any other ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of any such inconsistency.

SECTION 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective on January 10, 2019.

Re: Township Fire Prevention Program

Staff has developed the following recommendations for the Fire Prevention Program:

Intent:

The intent of the Fire Prevention Program is to establish a minimum fire safety and fire prevention standard for commercial, industrial, and institutional uses in order to help prevent injuries and losses.

Background:

The Township has adopted the Property Maintenance Code and conducts re-occupancy inspections of residential dwelling units, apartments, commercial establishments, and businesses upon a change of occupancy. The Property Maintenance Code requires the owner of a building with a sprinkler system to inspect, test, and maintain the system in accordance with NFPA 25. During the re-occupancy inspections, the inspectors look for Township specific life safety items, such as smoke detectors and GFIs.

Recommendation:

We would suggest the Board require the owners of buildings (~25) with sprinkler systems to provide the Township with a copy of their inspection report or test results on an annual basis. In addition we would suggest that the re-occupancy inspection be expanded to include the independent living units at the two life care facilities, since these are essentially apartments. The above recommendations can be implemented with our existing staff.

Draft Motion:

Mr. Chairman, I move that Board direct the township staff to begin implementation of the recommendations outlined above.

Re: Adelphia - Environmental Assessment

<u>Background</u> - At the December 4th meeting a resident suggested that the Board petition FERC to ask that Adelphia be required to prepare an Environmental Impact Statement as opposed to the Environmental Assessment.

There is a difference as noted in the excerpts below which are from the glossary on the FERC website (Emphasis added).

Environmental Assessment

An Environmental Assessment (EA) evaluates the consequences of a proposed action on the environment and recommends measures to minimize any potentially adverse affects. An EA is prepared when the environmental scoping process has determined that the project would not significantly affect the quality of the human environment.

Environmental Impact Statement

The statement required of federal agencies by Section 102 (C) of the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969, for major Federal actions that may significantly affect the quality of the human environment.

Next Step

The solicitor advised that since FERC has directed Adelphia to file an Environmental Assessment, simply filing a petition asking FERC to have Adelphia prepare an Environmental Impact Statement would not be successful. We would need to provide FERC with information that supports the request.

She suggested that once the Environmental Assessment was released: that we review it with to fine tooth comb to identify those issues that "may significantly affect the quality of the human environment". We could then file a petition citing those issues.

The Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) has reviewed the Hydrogeological Re-Evaluation Report and Supplemental Information associated with the Horizontal Directional Drill (HDD) Analysis submitted for the Strasburg Road/Bow Tree Drive Crossing, S3-0520, acknowledged in PA DEP Permit No. E15-862, and posted on DEP's Mariner East 2 pipeline portal's webpage on October 29, 2018.

DEP acknowledges the incorporation of the following best management practices to minimize the risk of Inadvertent Returns (IRs) and to minimize impacts to public and private water supplies during the construction phases of the HDD, and as detailed in your October 29, 2018, submission, Sunoco Pipeline, L.P. (SPLP), will:

- 1. Prior to the start of drilling activities, perform a geophysics analysis over the length of the profile for the S3-0520 HDD.
- 2. Incorporate proactive measures to prevent IRs and annulus subsidence, including continuous monitoring of the tool face pressure, record the drilling fluid pressures through the use of an annular pressure monitor, and by tracking the volume of the cuttings removed in both the pilot and reaming stages of the drill.
- 3. Incorporate annulus grouting procedures described in your submission to stabilize the borehole.

Considering the aforementioned, the Supplemental Information adequately addresses DEP's comments on the Hydrogeological Re-Evaluation Report. DEP has determined that no permit modifications are necessary. You may proceed with the permitted HDD activity in the

manner proposed in your reevaluation and in accordance with all applicable permit terms and conditions.
