**Smart 911** – Smart 911 is a new service in Chester County that allows you to create a Safety Profile at [www.smart911.com](http://www.smart911.com) that includes details you want the 9-1-1 center and public safety response teams to know about your household in an emergency. When you dial 9-1-1, from a phone associated with your Safety Profile that information automatically displays to the 9-1-1 call taker allowing them to send responders based on up-to-date location and emergency information. With your Safety Profile, responders can arrive aware of many details they would not otherwise know. Fire crews can arrive knowing exactly how many people live in your home and where the bedrooms are located. EMS personnel can know family members’ allergies or specific medical conditions. And police can access a photo of a missing family member in seconds rather than minutes or hours, helping the search start faster.

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EGT Pipeline Taskforce Recommendations for Comment Submission to FERC  
regarding the Environmental Analysis of the Adelpia Project

1. The Environmental Assessment (EA) is not adequate to assess the impact to our community. We urge FERC to complete an Environmental Impact Study (EIS) to provide a more detailed analysis and understanding of the Adelpia Pipeline's impact to the environment.
2. The EA notes that there is no significant impact on the environment from HDD. We know firsthand from our township, and larger community, experience with HDD on the Mariner East project that this isn't accurate. (Reference:

3. East Goshen Township requests more detailed investigation of the air quality both at the compressor station in Marcus Hook, and the blowdown tower in East Goshen Township.
4. We have questions regarding Adelpia's usage of the blowdown tower in EGT. What does the preplanning maintenance involve? Would they notify the public before offgassing? What is the decibel level threshold of the usage of this tower?
5. We want a condition of permitting the conversion of the valve station to the blowdown tower-Adelpia must adhere to local noise ordinances.
6. Adelpia should certify with FERC that they have all state and federal permits before the onset of this project.
7. We are asking for Adelpia to purchase, install and maintain leak detection and air quality monitoring at the blowdown tower.
8. East Goshen Township urges FERC to require Adelpia to issue a publicly-available risk assessment.

RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF EAST GOSHEN TOWNSHIP, CHESTER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, SETTING THE COMPENSATION OF THE EAST GOSHEN TOWNSHIP TAX COLLECTOR FOR THE TERM OF ELECTIVE OFFICE COMMENCING IN 2014 FOR THE COLLECTION AND FOR THE DEPOSIT OF REAL ESTATE TAXES LEVIED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF EAST GOSHEN TOWNSHIP.

**BE IT AND THE SAME IS HEREBY RESOLVED**, by the Board of Supervisors of East Goshen Township that the compensation of the East Goshen Township Tax Collector for the term of elective office commencing in 2014 for the collection and deposit of real estate taxes levied by East Goshen Township shall be as follows:

- 1) The Tax Collector's compensation for the collection of real estate taxes shall be in the sum of one dollar (\$1.00) per annum.
- 2) The Township shall pay all costs required for the collection of the real estate tax including but not limited to, the printing of bills, postage, and all materials, equipment and labor required for the collection of the real estate tax.
- 3) All taxes shall be deposited in the designated East Goshen Township bank account.
