



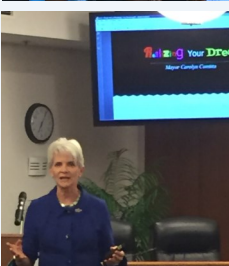
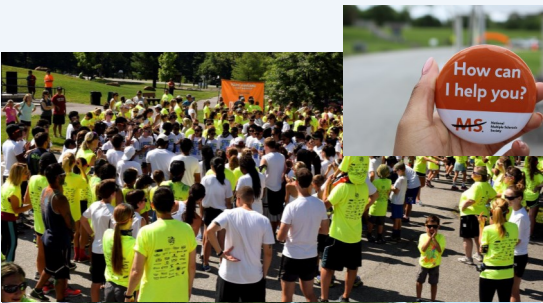
East Goshen Township Parks & Recreation Committed to Social Equity

Over \$500,000 has been raised for community causes in EGT parks since 2015. These include MS, youth mentoring and the installation of female restroom facilities in India among others.
