



East Goshen Township Parks & Recreation Committed to Health and Wellness

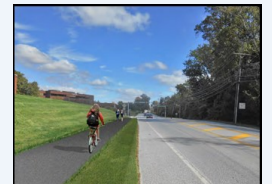


The 2016 Fit and Fun Township-wide health and wellness initiative included 1400 participants across a summer's worth of activities. The initiative was later named awarded the Gov. Wolf's 2017 Local Government's Excellence Award as the state's best health and wellness initiative for the year.

EGTPR supports mental health efforts through its Liv Live Concert and 22 in 22: Pushups for a Purpose events, raising awareness and providing resources for those suffering from mental health issues. Both were awarded PRPS Excellence Awards in 2017.



With overwhelming public support, EGTPR secured \$3.6M in grants and \$2.2M in municipal match to build the Paoli Pike Trail—a multimodal trail connecting land uses through the central municipal corridor. Construction anticipated for the first segments, fall 2019. In total, grants totally \$5.6M have been secured for EGTPR projects since 2016.



EGTPR is the only Pennsylvania P & R agency working with county resources in support of opioid efforts. Initiatives include program scholarships, Naloxone training and serving as the Chair of the PRPS Opioid Task Force.
