MS. EMANUEL: Now we get to our hearing. And I'll hand it over to Ryan.

MR. JENNINGS: Thank you, very much. Let's open the record for this evening's public hearing. This evening we will conduct a public hearing as part of the regularly scheduled public meeting to consider the adoption of amendment to certain provisions of the pension plan for the Goshen Fire Company.

First, the title and summary of the proposed Ordinance Amendment is as follows: An Ordinance amending certain provisions of the pension plan for the Goshen Fire Company which was established by the Board of Supervisors of East Goshen Township on May 5th, 1987 by Ordinance No. 78.

17 By way of Ordinance amendment introduction and background, prior Ordinance amendments of this type 18 19 have been enacted by the Board back in 1989, 2009 and 20 This amendment is necessary in light of the March 2011. 12th, 2019 collective bargaining agreement which was 21 22 reached between the Goshen Fire Company and the Goshen 23 Professional Fire Fighters' Association. The agreement 24 will govern the next four years.

If there are specific questions regarding the

1	changes to the agreement, Mr. Altshul is here and able
2	to address them. While the Township is not a party to
3	the collective bargaining agreement, the Township is the
4	sponsor of the Fire Fighters' pension plan, which was
5	authorized by Township Ordinance, again, in 1987. As
6	such, in order for the Goshen Fire Company to execute
7	the new agreement, the Township must enact this
8	Ordinance.
