Discussion:

While the playground has been met with near unanimous applause, it is a large space. Subsequently, the only aspect of the space that parents have questioned is the addition of more shade. Recently, the Friends of East Goshen completed the second playground brick campaign, and are looking for a playground improvement project to fund. Recreation Resource USA provided the following quote for a shade structure (see attached).

- The location would be in the sand area. This makes the most sense for a number of reasons:
 - o Easily installed, sand can be readily moved
 - Toddlers utilize this area the most in a static play capacity
- Installation would take ten days, one day for the post, ten days for curing, and one day to mount the square shade sail.

The Friends of East Goshen are willing to fund the $12' \times 12'$ shade sail (\$8587), it is my recommendation to request the additional \$386 from the Board of Supervisors to move to the $15' \times 15'$ shade sail.

Motion:

I move to recommend the Board of Supervisors approve the installation of a 15' x 15' shade sail.
