In attendance were: 8 Chairman Erich Meyer, Walter Wujcik, Andy Tyler and Scott Sanders. 9 10 Call to Order 11 Erich called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. 12 13 Pledge of Allegiance & Moment of Silence 14 Erich led those present in the Pledge of Allegiance and then asked for a moment of silence to 15 remember those who serve in our military and our first responders. 16 17 Minutes 18 The minutes of the April 10, 2019 meeting were approved as corrected. 19 20 **Old Business** 21 1. Keep East Goshen Beautiful Day - This annual event was held on April 13, 2019. Board 22 members were very pleased with the participation this year. There was a good number of 23 organizations that did their clean up on a different day. 24 2. Spring Planting - The Board decided to move this to the Fall. 25 26 Liaison Report 27 1. Municipal Authority - Walter mentioned that he forwarded the list of trees for the 28 replacement of trees along the property with the sewer plant to Mark Miller. 29 30 **Any Other Matter** 31 1. Erich mentioned a company called Curb My Clutter that takes items that can't go to the 32 landfill. About 10 municipalities in the tri-state area are using them. Walter will check it 33 34 2. The purpose of this letter is to inform you that the equitable owner of 1531 Paoli Pike, West Chester, PA 19380, The Hankin Group, has submitted a sketch plan for review and comment by the Township Planning Commission. The property consists of two lots with a combined lot area of approximately 8.1 acres and is located in the Business Park (BP) zoning district.

The Hankin Group (equitable owner) is seeking feedback from the Township Planning Commission on developing the property as a Planned Apartment Development. The BP district is not currently zoned for a Planned Apartment Development use. The applicant will require a zoning change to accommodate their proposed plan.
