34	A. Discuss potential Township ordinances regarding single use plastic bag bans
35	(Mary) discussed that there is a one-year moratorium at the state level with regards to a
36	plastic bag ban. The Borough of West Chester passed a ban, waiting until July 2020 as
37	a start date. Question was raised, what do we do in the interim? Committee Decided to
38	continue meeting with business owners and hen make a recommendation to EGS.
39	B. Update on hauling services
40	(Tom) stated we fall under the county plan. He proposed we state a goal; his
41	recommendation was 25% over the next five years. (Christi) Maybe we should explore
42	alternative uses for glass. Jeff stated we could easily create a social media campaign to
43	communicate the goal. Tom made a motion to recommend setting a goal of 25% trash

1	reduction over the next tive years. Kipp seconded and all other committee members
2	were in favor.
3	C. Update on electric car charging stations (Jeff)
4	Jeff reached out to Tesla regarding charging stations, who is actively looking to place
5	more in the greater West Chester area. Waiting on response. If Tesla is interested, we
6	would need to pitch the 2-3 potential locations.

8	A. DVPRC update regarding feasibility of solar power at municipal facilities &n WCCOG -
9	Energy Transition Plan update (Jon)
10	DVRPC is analyzing the potential for solar power within the five Energy Plan
11	municipalities, might be an option to jointly use a Power Purchase Agreement. He invited
12	the SAC to the next COG meeting, that will include an Energy Plan discussion, on
13	September 12 th .
