Members in 8 attendance are indicated in bold: 9 Chairman Ted Roberts, Chairman 10 Mary Urbine, Vice Chairman 11 Kelly Bidegary, 12 Ed Lendrat, 13 Kathleen Lynch, 14 **Charles Proctor** 15 Lazarus Zarogiannis 16 17 <u>Call to Order</u> – Ted called the meeting to order. 18 19 Pledge of Allegiance - Ted led the Pledge of Allegiance and asked for a moment of silence 20 for our first responders, military and to remember 9/11. 21 22 Minutes 23 The minutes of the August 8, 2019 meeting were approved. The July meeting was cancelled due to severe weather. 24 25 26 **Old Business** 27 1. Ornament - Ted provided drawings of the proposed 2019 Sullivan House ornament 28 which will be three-dimensional. It is ordered for production to start tomorrow. It will sell 29 for \$20.00. It will also be offered in a package, which will consist of 2018 and 2019 30 ornaments and a copy of the East Goshen Township Images of America history book. There 31 was discussion about the possible events to sell it. 32 2. Historic Ghost Tour - This event will be held on Saturday, October 19, 2019 from 6:00 33 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. in the historic area. Ted is working with Jason Lang. They feel 200 people 34 should be the limit. There will be 3 stations for the ghost story telling. Ted described the 35 ghost stories. The cost is \$5.00/person. Volunteers should be there at 5:00 p.m. 36 Training/rehearsal will be held on Thursday or Friday. Next year they will start in the park 37 and get them back via hayride. If anyone has a story, let Ted know. 38 39 **New Business** 40 1. 2020 Budget - Chuck discussed the budget and recommended making some changes to 41 include the ornament and events. It will have to be presented to the Board of Supervisors. 42 2. <u>Local Service Utility Structures</u> - Chuck commented that the historical design for utility 43 sheds probably will not be accepted. The cost to the utility would be high and the process 44 for approval would be timely. 45 **Any Other Matter** 46 47 1. Ed mentioned that all of his research materials are now in the Township building. 48 2. Brochures - Kathleen will do one for the Sullivan House. Chuck mentioned that, every 49 time we do something in print about the Sullivan House, their committee needs to see it 50 first.
