Call to Order – Ted called the meeting to order.

Pledge of Allegiance – Ted led the Pledge of Allegiance and asked for a moment of silence for our first responders, military and to remember 9/11.

Minutes

The minutes of the August 8, 2019 meeting were approved. The July meeting was cancelled due to severe weather.

Old Business

1. **Ornament** – Ted provided drawings of the proposed 2019 Sullivan House ornament which will be three-dimensional. It is ordered for production to start tomorrow. It will sell for \$20.00. It will also be offered in a package, which will consist of 2018 and 2019 ornaments and a copy of the East Goshen Township Images of America history book. There was discussion about the possible events to sell it.

2. **Historic Ghost Tour** – This event will be held on Saturday, October 19, 2019 from 6:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. in the historic area. Ted is working with Jason Lang. They feel 200 people should be the limit. There will be 3 stations for the ghost story telling. Ted described the ghost stories. The cost is \$5.00/person. Volunteers should be there at 5:00 p.m. Training/rehearsal will be held on Thursday or Friday. Next year they will start in the park and get them back via hayride. If anyone has a story, let Ted know.

New Business

1. **2020 Budget** – Chuck discussed the budget and recommended making some changes to include the ornament and events. It will have to be presented to the Board of Supervisors.

2. **Local Service Utility Structures** – Chuck commented that the historical design for utility sheds probably will not be accepted. The cost to the utility would be high and the process for approval would be timely.

Any Other Matter

1. Ed mentioned that all of his research materials are now in the Township building.
2. Brochures – Kathleen will do one for the Sullivan House. Chuck mentioned that, every time we do something in print about the Sullivan House, their committee needs to see it first.
