CHAIRMAN'S REPORT

NEW BUSINESS

- 1. NRPA Gold Medal Finalist The plaque was displayed so the commission members could see it. Dan and Jason spoke about the award and the application process. They met many groups from around the US.
- 2. <u>Update on Paoli Pike Trail</u> The ground breaking ceremony was on Tuesday September 16, 2019. Construction on sections F & G has started and should be done in 2 months.
