Enclosed is a Department of the Army Permit (Enclosure 1) authorizing East Goshen Township to breach the existing Hershey's Mill Dam and convert the approximate 2-acre reservoir to waterways, pond, and wetlands within a park setting. The site is located northeast of the intersection of Greenhill and Hershey Mill Roads, in East Goshen Township, Chester County, Pennsylvania. Also enclosed is a notice of authorization (ENG Form 4336-Enclosure 2) to be conspicuously displayed at the site of work.

Carefully review all the terms and conditions of the Department of the Army permit and understand them fully. Performing any work not specifically authorized by the permit or failing to comply with its conditions may subject you and/or your contractor to the enforcement provisions of our regulations. If a contractor performs the work for you, both you and the contractor are responsible for assuring the work is done in conformance with the conditions and limitations of this permit. Please be sure the person who will do the work has read and understands the conditions of the permit.

This office shall be notified of the commencement and completion of the permitted work. To assist you in meeting this requirement, enclosed are a Notification/Certification of Work Commencement Form (Enclosure 3) and a Notification/Certification of Work Completion/Compliance Form (Enclosure 4) which must be signed and returned to this office. Additional information concerning this permit may be obtained by writing to David Caplan of my office at the above address or calling at 215-656-6731.

If any material changes in the location or plans of the permitted work are found necessary on account of unforeseen or altered conditions or otherwise, revised plans should be submitted

promptly to this office in order that the revised plans, if found unobjectionable, may receive the approval required by law before operations on the permitted work are commenced.

NOTE: The term "you" and its derivatives, as used in this permit, means the permittee or any future transferee. The term "this office" refers to the appropriate district or division office of the Corps of Engineers having jurisdiction over the permitted activity or the appropriate official of that office acting under the authority of the commanding officer.

You are authorized to perform work in accordance with the terms and conditions specified below.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: to breach the existing Hershey's Mill Dam and convert the approximate 2-acre reservoir to waterways, pond, and wetlands within a park setting. The work includes restoration and re-configuration of the 563 foot long main tributary and 340 linear feet of smaller tributaries. The work also includes the construction of a 5,242 square foot pond within the waterway and wetlands with an outfall weir to the re-configured stream channel. The project will involve the placement of a pedestrian boardwalk on reinforced concrete piles through the impoundment area. A total of 1.10 acre of wetland and 0.18 acre of stream would be impacted for the total project which would result in loss of 0.18 acre of wetlands and enhancement of 1.78 acre of wetlands as well as 0.28 acre of stream restoration/creation (940 linear feet of re-configured and enhanced channel) and 338 linear feet (0.07 acre) of stream channel loss. The project will also include temporary impacts to waters and wetlands for site de-watering by cofferdam construction, erosion and sediment control measures, temporary construction access, and temporary soil stockpile areas.

All work is to be completed in accordance with the attached plan(s) E1 through E5 and the approved plans described herein.

PROJECT LOCATION: The site is located northeast of the intersection of Greenhill and Hershey Mill Roads, in East Goshen Township, Chester County, Pennsylvania.

PERMIT CONDITIONS:

General Conditions:

1. The time limit for completing the work authorized ends on December 31, 2024. If you find that you need more time to complete the authorized activity, submit your request for a time extension to this office for consideration at least one month before the above date is reached.
2. You must maintain the activity authorized by this permit in good condition and in conformance with the terms and conditions of this permit. You are not relieved of this requirement if you abandon the permitted activity, although you may make a good faith transfer to a third party in compliance with General Condition 4 below. Should you wish to cease to maintain the authorized activity or should you desire to abandon it without a good faith transfer, you must obtain a modification of this permit from this office, which may require restoration of the area.
3. If you discover any previously unknown historic or archeological remains while accomplishing the activity authorized by this permit, you must immediately notify this office of what you have found. We will initiate the Federal and State coordination required to determine if the remains warrant a recovery effort or if the site is eligible for listing in the National Register of Historic Places.
4. If you sell the property associated with this permit, you must obtain the signature of the new owner in the space provided and forward a copy of the permit to this office to validate the transfer of this authorization.
5. If a conditioned water quality certification has been issued for your project, you must comply with conditions specified in the certification as special conditions to this permit.
6. You must allow representatives from this office to inspect the authorized activity at any time deemed necessary to ensure that it is being or has been accomplished in accordance with the terms and conditions of your permit.

Special Conditions:

1. All work performed in association with the above noted project shall be conducted in accordance with the attached Sheets E1 through E-5 and the 34-page project plan set prepared by Gannett Fleming entitled "Decommissioning of Hershey's Mill Dam (DEP ID No. D15-125), East Goshen Township, Chester County, Pennsylvania," Project Number 060466, dated September 2019.
2. Construction activities shall not result in the disturbance or alteration of greater than 2.0 acre of waters of the United States.
3. Any deviation in construction methodology or project design from that shown on the above noted drawings must be approved by this office, in writing, prior to performance of the work.

This includes any modifications deemed necessary by the contractor at the time of construction. Any regulated work, including work described in narrative construction notes, not expressly reviewed herein is not considered approved. All modifications to the above noted project plans shall be approved, in writing, by this office. No work shall be performed prior to written approval of this office.

4. This office shall be notified at least 10 days prior to the commencement of authorized work by completing and signing the attached *Notification/ Certification of Work Commencement Form*. This office shall also be notified within 10 days of the completion of the authorized work by completing and signing the attached *Notification/Certification of Work Completion/Compliance Form*. All notifications required by this condition shall be in writing and shall be transmitted to this office by registered mail. Oral notifications are not acceptable. Similar notification is required each time maintenance work is to be done under the terms of this Corps of Engineers permit.

5. That all temporary fills authorized by this permit shall be removed in their entirety, and the area returned to its pre-construction condition prior to the expiration of this authorization.

6. The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers shall be notified a minimum of 7 days prior to all Pre-Construction Conferences.

7. That all equipment required to traverse wetland areas shall be supported on mats.

1. Congressional Authorities: You have been authorized to undertake the activity described above pursuant to:

2. Limits of this authorization.

a. This permit does not obviate the need to obtain other Federal, State, or local authorizations required by law.

b. This permit does not grant any property rights or exclusive privileges.

c. This permit does not authorize any injury to the property or rights of others.

d. This permit does not authorize interference with any existing or proposed Federal projects.

3. Limits of Federal Liability. In issuing this permit, the Federal Government does not assume any liability for the following:

a. Damages to the permitted project or uses thereof as a result of other permitted or unpermitted activities or from natural causes.

b. Damages to the permitted project or uses thereof as a result of current or future activities undertaken by or on behalf of the United States in the public interest.

c. Damages to persons, property, or to other permitted or unpermitted activities or structures caused by the activity authorized by this permit.

d. Design or construction deficiencies associated with the permitted work.

e. Damage claims associated with any future modification, suspension, or revocation of this permit.

4. Reliance on Applicant's Data. The determination of this office that issuance of this permit is not contrary to the public interest was made in reliance on the information you provided.

5. Reevaluation of Permit Decision. This office may reevaluate its decision on this permit at any time the circumstances warrant. Circumstances that could require a reevaluation include, but are not limited to, the following:

a. You fail to comply with the terms and conditions of this permit.

b. The information provided by you in support of your permit application proves to have been false, incomplete, or inaccurate (see 4 above).

c. Significant new information surfaces which this office did not consider in reaching the original public interest decision.

Such a reevaluation may result in a determination that it is appropriate to use the suspension, modification, and revocation procedures contained in 33 CFR 325.7 or enforcement procedures such as those contained in 33 CFR 326.4 and 326.5. The referenced enforcement procedures provide for the issuance of an administrative order requiring you to comply with the terms and conditions of your permit and for the initiation of legal action where appropriate. You will be required to pay for any corrective measures ordered by this office, and if you fail to comply with such directive, this office may in certain situations (such as those specified in 33 CFR 209.170) accomplish the corrective measures by contract or otherwise and bill you for the cost.

6. Extensions. General Condition 1 establishes a time limit for the completion of the activity authorized by this permit. Unless there are circumstances requiring either a prompt completion of the authorized activity or a reevaluation of the public interest decision, the Corps will normally give favorable consideration to a request for an extension of this time limit.

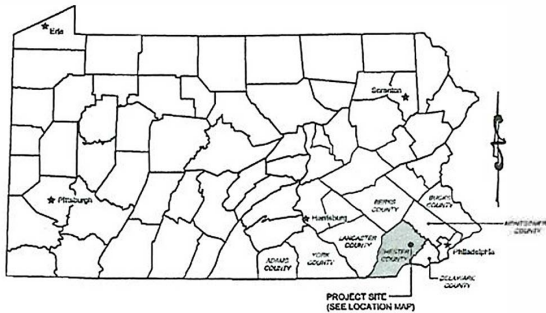

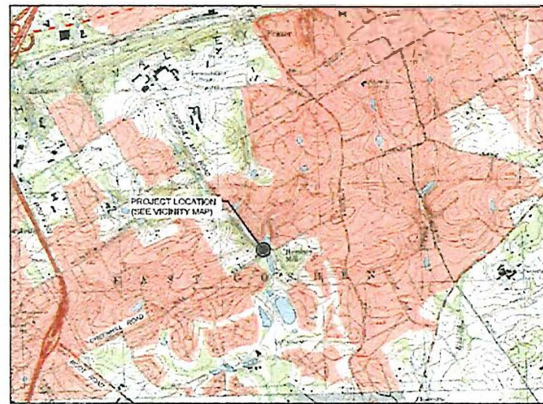

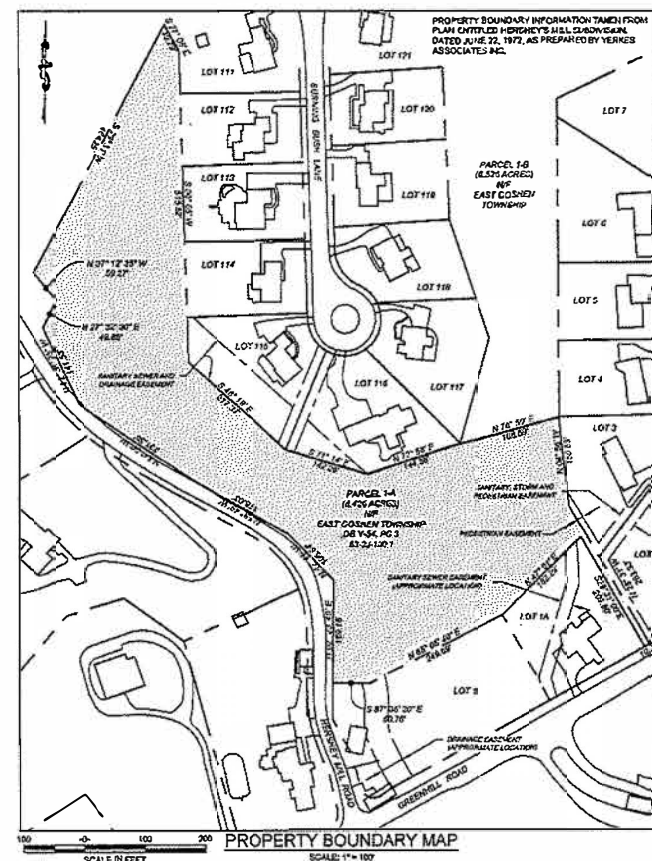
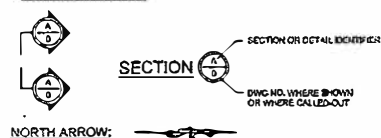
PROJECT GENERAL NOTES

4. ALL DIMENSIONS AND EXISTING CONDITIONS SHALL BE CHECKED AND VERIFIED BY THE CONTRACTOR AT THE SITE PRIOR TO THE START OF CONSTRUCTION AND PRIOR TO ORDERING MATERIALS.
5. IT SHALL BE THE CONTRACTOR'S RESPONSIBILITY TO THOROUGHLY REVIEW AND UNDERSTAND THE EXISTING UTILITY RECORDS AND TO BE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE DETECTION OF ANY ERRORS, OMISSIONS, AND/OR DISCREPANCIES PRIOR TO THE START OF CONSTRUCTION AND PRIOR TO ORDERING MATERIALS.
6. PROPOSED CONDUITS REPRESENT EXISTING GRADE, ILL, TOP OF TUBESOL, TOP OF PAVEMENT, TOP OF ROCK/RIPPRAP, ETC.
7. MATCH EXISTING GRADES, CURB HEIGHTS, SIDEWALK WIDTHS, ETC. AT ALL LOCATIONS WHENHOLDING EXISTING UTILITY RECORDS TO EXISTING FACILITIES.
8. RAISE OR LOWER ALL EXISTING UTILITY VALVES, COVERS, GRATINGS, ETC. AS NEEDED TO BE FLUSH WITH THE PROPOSED PAVEMENT GRADE.
9. ALL EXISTING UTILITIES SHOWN ON THE PLANS ARE BASED ON THE BEST AVAILABLE INFORMATION. THE ENGINEER AND OWNER DO NOT CERTIFY THE CORRECTNESS OR COMPLETENESS OF THE EXISTING UTILITY PORTRAITAL. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL CONTACT ALL UTILITY COMPANIES AND TO THE MAXIMUM EXTENT POSSIBLE, OBTAIN RECORDS ALONG BOTH GREENHILL ROAD AND HERSEY MILL ROAD THROUGHOUT THE CONSTRUCTION PERIOD.
10. THE PROJECT WILL INVOLVE WORK WITHIN THE HERSEY'S MILL DAM RESERVOR WHICH HAS A CONTRIBUTING DRAINAGE AREA OF APPROXIMATELY 18 SQUARE MILES. WATER ELEVATIONS AT GREENHILL SITE WILL VARY DEPENDING ON STREAM FLOWS AND WEATHER CONDITIONS. THE CONTRACTOR IS MADE AWARE THAT STREAM AND/OR RESERVOR LEVELS WILL VARY. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL MAKE PROVISIONS FOR CONDUCTING WORK IN VARIABLE WATER DEPTHS AND SHALL NOT BE RESPONSIBLE FOR SUCH WATER DEPTHS OR FLOODS.
11. ALL CONSTRUCTION EQUIPMENT, WITH THE EXCEPTION OF DEWATERING EQUIPMENT, SHALL BE REMOVED FROM THOSE AREAS OF THE RESERVOR LOCATED BELOW THE SPILLWAY CREST (EIL 447.42 AT THE END OF EACH WORK DAY). FUEL TANKS / CONTAINERS SHALL NOT BE LOCATED IN OR ADJACENT TO WATERBODIES WITHIN AREAS THAT MAY BECOME INUNDATED BY STORAGE FLOODS.
12. ALL TREES LOCATED WITHIN THE WORK AREA ARE TO REMAIN SHALL BE PROTECTED WITH FISHNETS OR OTHER PROTECTIVE FENCE AT THE DRIP LINE OF EACH TREE TO BE PROTECTED, AT NO TIME SHALL VEHICLES, EQUIPMENT, AND/OR MATERIALS BE STORED OVER EXISTING TREE ROOTS. NO TRUCKS SHALL VEHICLES OF ANY KIND BE ALLOWED TO TRAVEL OR PARK ON EXISTING TREE ROOTS.
13. CONTRACTOR SHALL NOTIFY THE PA FISH AND WILD COMMISSION SOUTHEAST REGIONAL OFFICE (PHONE NUMBER: 484-250-5900) AT LEAST FIVE DAYS PRIOR TO THE START OF CONSTRUCTION.
14. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL NOTIFY THE CHESTER COUNTY CONSERVATION DISTRICT (PHONE NUMBER: 814-325-4020) AT LEAST SEVEN DAYS PRIOR TO THE START OF CONSTRUCTION AND ADVISE THAT THE COMPLETION OF THE PROJECT. THE DISTRICT SHALL HAVE A DETERMINATION OF THE SITE IS PERMANENTLY STABILIZED AND IF THE TEMPORARY EROSION CONTROL FACILITIES CAN BE REMOVED FROM SERVICE.
15. UNTIL THE SITE IS PERMANENTLY STABILIZED, ALL EROSION CONTROL FACILITIES SHALL BE MAINTAINED PROPERLY. MAINTENANCE SHALL INCLUDE INSPECTION OF ALL FACILITIES AND THE CONSTRUCTION OF ANY FACILITIES THAT MAY BE REQUIRED TO MAINTAIN FACILITY WORK, INCLUDING CLEANING, REPAIR, REPLACEMENT, REGRADING, RESEEDING, REPAIRS, AND ANCHORING OF SUCH MATERIAL, SHALL BE PERFORMED IMMEDIATELY.
16. HERSEY'S MILL DAM WAS CONSTRUCTED IN THE LATE EIGHTEENTH CENTURY TO SUPPORT A GRINDING MILL. THE MILL BUILDING WAS DESTROYED BY A FLOODING OF THE RESERVOR IN 1904 AND THE CONTRACTOR IS MADE AWARE THAT EXCAVATION ACTIVITIES MAY ENCOUNTER REMNANTS OF PAST CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES AND NO ADDITIONAL PAYMENT WILL BE MADE TO REMOVE A GRINDING MILL.

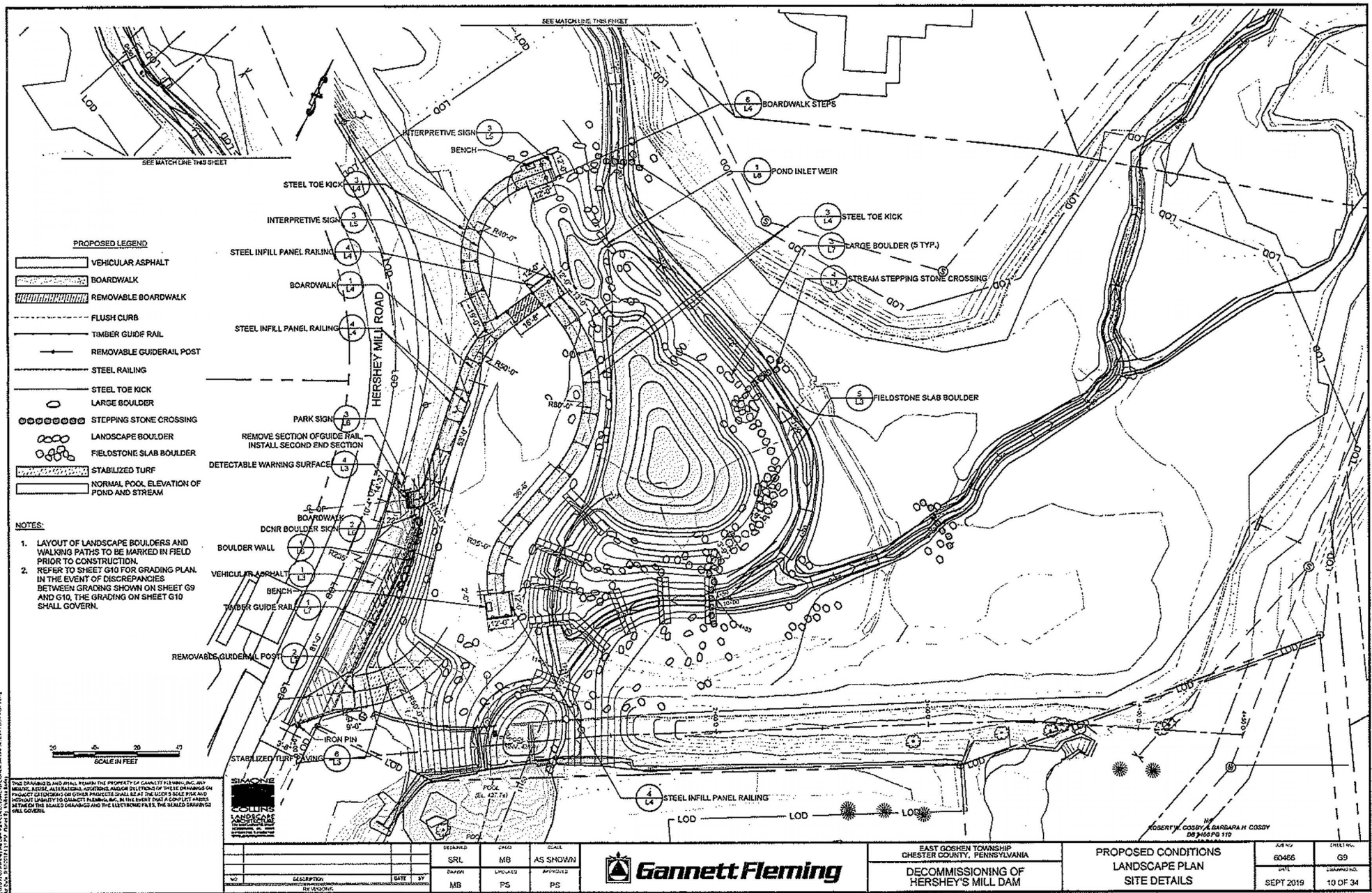

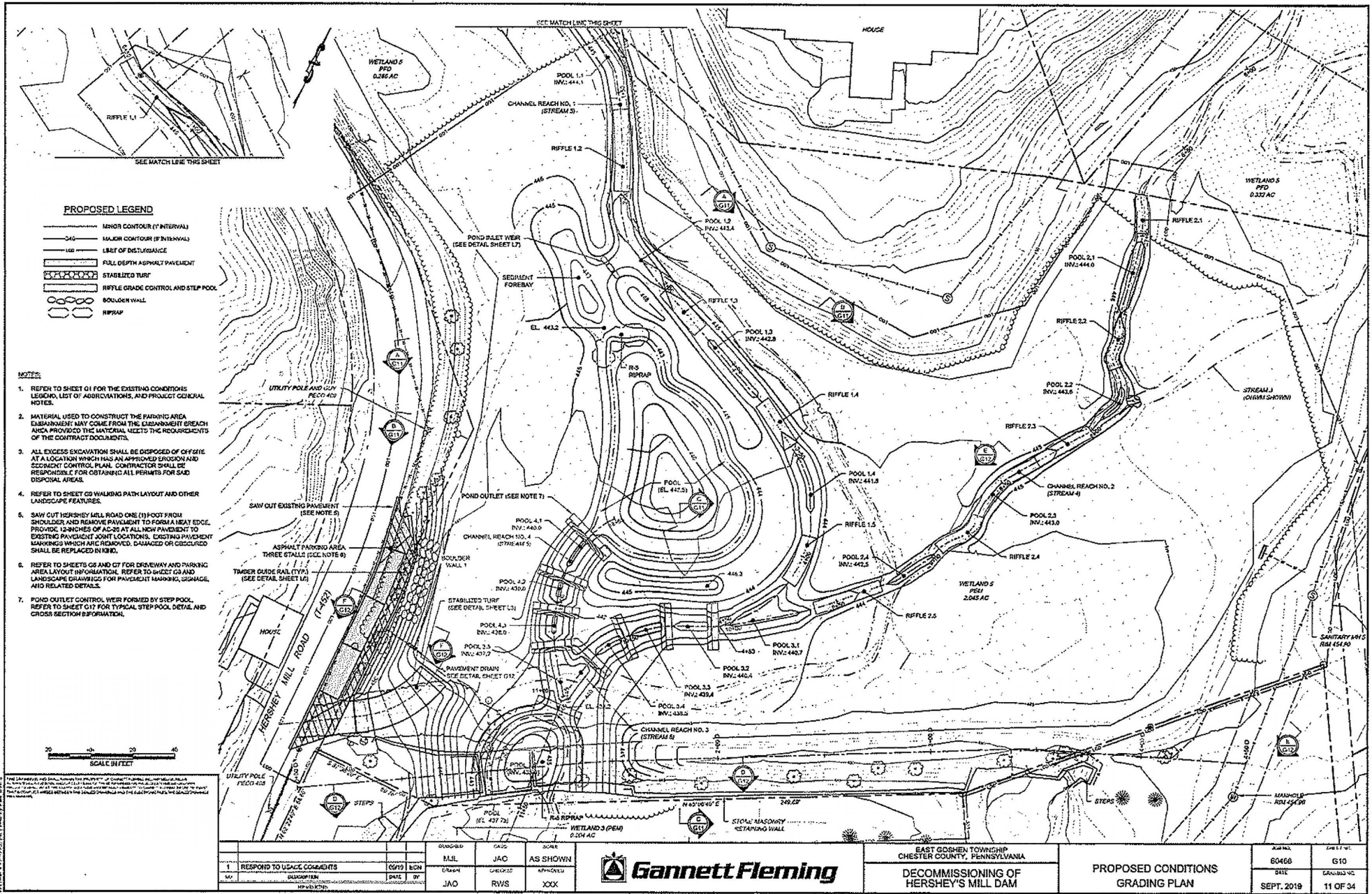
