37	B. ORDINANCE AMENDMENTS				
38	1. TND Ordinance Overlay Final Draft – The Commission members reviewed the final draft and agreed				
39	that it contains all of the items they discussed at their last meeting.				
40	Public Discussion:				
41	Christina Morley, member of the Pipeline Task Force – She asked if the Planning Commission has				
42	considered the pipeline and setbacks. She mentioned the Risk Assessment that was done but sees no				
43	mention of it in this plan. The PUC was requested to have the Risk Assessment done but they didn't so				
44	local municipalities had it done. The pipeline was here first and then development occurred. Officials				
45	didn't understand the danger, so building was done along it. We must continue to take the initiative.				
46	Ernie – He feels this should be looked at later with a comprehensive approach that would cover all				
47	ordinances.				
48	David Shuey – He mentioned that the blast area is 3,000 ft. The pipeline company does not have to				
49 50	follow local setbacks. He also pointed out that there are restrictions on easements.				
50 51	Mike Lynch – He mentioned coastal zoning with the more dangerous hurricanes and the possibility of not				
51 52	allowing rebuilding. He feels that, if it is looked at, it will be done later in a very comprehensive way. Marty Shane – He mentioned that he is a member of the Chester Co. Planning Commission and this has
