They felt the area between the Veterans Pavilion and the restrooms would be best. He could install 1 large and 1 small court. Mark will provide the digging and stone. 2. 2020 Park & Recreation Goals – The ABC annual meeting will be held on Tuesday January 28, 2020 at 6:00 p.m. instead of Saturday morning. Jason proposed the following goals for 2020:

- a. Create a formal activity and marketing plan for the Paoli Pike Trail (C-G) for 2021
- b. Develop a plan to begin offering a full day camp program at East Goshen Elementary in 2021
- c. Finalize design elements for the amphitheater band shell in preparation for 2021 grant applications
- d. Install a bocce court in EGT Park in partnership with a local Eagle Scout
- e. Collaborate with the West Chester Garden Club to create the Nature Warriors program
- f. Strive to increase resident volunteering by 50% in 2020
- g. Communicate nearby nature attractions

The Commission members agreed with these goals.
