We are sending this letter as a courtesy to share information on upcoming pipeline construction activity in your area.

The two workspace areas for horizontal directional drill 521, or HDD 521, will be at the intersection of 352 / Bowtree Drive in East Goshen Township and behind the BP Station on West Chester Pike Road in Westtown Township. Attached to this letter is a map of the two workspace areas associated with this drill. Energy Transfer's pipeline contractor, Michels, recently completed the installation of the 16-inch pipeline along this segment and will now be moving to install the 20-inch pipeline.

### **Drill Specifics**

- Length of HDD 521 – 20-inch pipeline: 6943'
- Duration of 20-inch pipeline installation: Approximately 220 days from start\*

\*The duration to complete these drills is always subject to change due to weather and other factors.

### **Site Activity**

Michels has previously mobilized onto these workspace areas to complete the 16-inch pipeline installation. They will now shift their equipment within the workspace area and line up to begin the installation of the 20-inch pipeline. Prior to beginning the 20-inch pipeline segment, Michels will be installing a steel casing to support their operations at the site. The installation of this casing may take up to a week to complete and at times will be very loud.

In addition to following all occupational safety and health administration regulations, we are taking various measures to mitigate noise. These measures include sound walls and source mitigation on and around certain equipment.
