37 start. T. Kilburn asked why nuclear wasn't considered in the plan. T. Kilburn also
38 stated his preference if agreeing to the PPA would be to source local Chesco
39 energy. J. Altshul noted if we did that there would likely be no cost savings to the
40 Township. K. Happ will explore this further. The SAC made the following
