Altshul noted that criteria for prioritizing the recommendations should focus on free/low cost and or easily implemented changes. D. Shuey discussed that a move to a hybrid vehicle fleet made sense. B. Hutchison discussed homeowner solar purchasing agreements and the Township's potential role. D. Shuey asked who does the due diligence to vet and/or select vendors, that would need to be on the collective homeowners.
