 - a. No one recording meeting other than J. Lang for the minutes.
- 5. Chairman's Report
 - a. C. Supple remarked that it is wonderful to be a part of the SAC adventure. The committee has come through with flying colors, a great adventure this year. She discussed the possibility of signing on with other environmental groups like the regional green house gas initiative, REGGIE. PA is the only state not a part of this in the regional area. Christi read a sample letter of support for REGGIE and discussed potential benefits. B. Hutchison will be sending in personal endorsement for REGGIE. D. Shuey recommended individuals send in personal endorsements rather than the Township. M. Kruger asked what about the purpose of the recommendation. C. Supple said simply looking for additional groups to sign on in support for REGGIE. C. Supple to distribute the sample four page letter. The ossie was tabled for now, future discussions to be had. The Gardener Laureate has been selected and will be announced in early 2021.

a. J. Lang explained the January ABC reorganization procedure, described the positions that would be open, and urged the committee to think about nominations. He thanked C. Supple for her two years as SAC Chair, noting she was the first Chair of the brand new committee, and did an exceptional job with limited guidance or historical precedent. The January meeting will open with the reorganization.

 - a. C. Supple remarked that there are so many potential initiatives we can work on. D. Shuey suggested maybe adding 1-2 people more or sub committees that work together on special projects and also communicate with the BOS. Some of the dicussed initiatives included: business outreach, awards for best practices, and greener options at lower costs. The plastic bag ban has been indefinitely suspended by the state government. Maybe make recycle bins more readily available for businesses. It wouldn't be banning plastic, but at least it could be recycled. K. Markus cautioned SAC from pushing for something like this; as a small business owner it would be onerous and expensive to make happen. She said maybe the SAC adopt ways to change within system to reduce or eliminate in business processes. M. Kruger remarked that Trex decks offers community program where they give you two bins for bags, once they have 500 lbs. take it to Giant. M. Kruger said Patti (Chester County Waste) passed on that there is no talk of stopping the plastic film pilot program. K. Markus offered to collect 2021 goal input (based on criteria/point system) and create a prioritized list. C. Supple will collect individual input and put together for the January SAC meeting.
