b. Blue Bird Boxes – Dan cleaned them in the spring and checked them through the summer. He will continue to check them. He wants to develop a best practices guide.

c. Riparian Buffers – Locations were discussed.

d. Weeds Inc. – Walter thanked Sandy for contacting them to continue spraying the invasives.

e. Pond Restoration – These projects have been put on hold because of budget deferrals. Marydell Pond is done. Bowtree Pond is next. Michele mentioned that Mark Miller may be able to put boulders in the Bowtree pond to cut down on the silt.

The 2021 goals will be finalized at the January meeting. Sandy commented that the Board of Supervisors may also have a project for the CB to do.

1. Board of Supervisors – Michele reported that they plan to adopt the 2021 budget on December 15, 2020. Malvern Library funding was restored to 2020 levels. The position of Finance Director is still open. Interviews are being done. January 4, 2020 will be their reorganization meeting.
